Public Drop Off Depot

Take advantage of the Depot to dispose of excess Garbage, Yard Waste and Recyclables. The Depot is located at North Service Rd. E. and Central Ave. in Windsor. Residents can drop off Recyclables, cardboard, metal items (including appliances), Yard Waste (including leaves, tree trimmings & grass clippings), tires and garbage. All Recyclables can be dropped off FREE OF CHARGE. Garbage (over 100 kg), Yard Waste, freon appliances, and tires will be assessed a disposal fee.

Hours of Operation:

Summer Hours: Mar. thru Nov.

Mon. - Sat.: 8:00 a.m. to 4:45 p.m.

Winter Hours: Dec., Jan., Feb.

Mon. - Fri.: 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

Sat.: 9:00 a.m. to 12:45 p.m.

Recycling Tips:

- Please ensure newspaper is secure so that it doesn't blow through your neighbourhood.
- Do not put garbage or food waste in with Recyclables.
- Broken glass can injure collection workers and should never be placed in Recycling Boxes or garbage cans.
- If the recycling driver left material behind, it means:
 - it was not packaged properly, or
 - that it is NOT recyclable
- It's your Recycling Boxes that signal the driver to stop. Place them in a visible location at the curb.
- PLEASE RECYCLE ALL CARDBOARD.

HCW Depot & Reuse Centre

Leftover household chemical waste (HCW) should be dropped off at the depot - never throw it in the garbage. Dispose of your leftover paint, stains, propane tanks, etc. - **free of charge.**

The Reuse Centre is part of the HCW Depot. You can pick up leftover paint, etc. - free of charge.

The HCW Depot is located at the same site as the Public Drop Off Depot (see map above for location).

Recycling Basics

- ALL PAPER PRODUCTS should be placed in the Red Box.
- ALL CONTAINERS (bottles and cans) should be placed in the Blue Box.
- Please do NOT place any plastic bags in recycling boxes. They are not recyclable in our program. Thank you.

Red Box - All paper products

- 1 Place these items LOOSE in the Red Box. Please remove all plastic inserts and wrappers from the newspaper.

- Newspapers & Inserts
- Magazines
- Catalogues
- Flyers
- Phone Books
- Paperback Books
- Gift Cards & Gift Wrap
- Office / Computer Paper
- Junkmail
- Envelopes



- 2 Cardboard must be recycled!

Either breakdown and place out in bundles weighing less than 20 kgs. / 40 lbs. (76 cm X 76 cm X 1 metre) OR place all your cardboard boxes into a larger box for collection. Remember it cannot exceed 20 kgs!



Place next to your Red Box!

- 3 Flatten all paper containers and place in a paper bag or box. Items such as:

- Cereal, Cracker, Tissue, Pasta & Cookie Boxes
- Gift Boxes
- Paper Bags & Tubes



Blue Box - All Containers

- 1 Place these items LOOSE in the Blue Box. Flatten and remove caps / lids.

- Pop Cans
- Juice Cans
- Food Cans
- Glass Bottles
- Glass Jars



CRUSH your pop cans and plastic bottles! Now 3 items take the space of 1.

- 2 Recycle ALL plastic bottles that have an opening smaller than the base. Just CHECK THE NECK!

Most plastic bottles are recyclable. Please EMPTY and FLATTEN prior to placing them in your Blue Box. Recycle these bottles:

- Water Bottles
- Pop / Juice Bottles
- Household Cleaner
- Liquid Soap
- Bleach Bottles
- Lotion / Mouthwash
- Shampoo / Conditioner



Plastic Bottles ONLY. No TUBS please.



NOT ACCEPTED:

Shopping bags, wraps, toys, medical supplies, tubs, flower pots, food storage containers, & laundry scoops.
