

**“National Volunteer Week”
April 14-20, 2024**

- WHEREAS:** Volunteers in Windsor-Essex have stepped up during the pandemic and beyond to support families, friends, neighbours, and strangers, people standing up to systemic racism and prejudice, and people sharing insights on how to create a more just and equitable society; and,
- WHEREAS:** Windsor’s volunteers are individuals, families, workers, retirees, community members of all ages and backgrounds; and,
