

PROCLAMATION

"World Town Planning Day" November 8, 2023

- WHEREAS: November 8th Planners in over 30 countries recognize World Town Planning Day, an international practice that began in 1949; and,
- WHEREAS: The Southwest District of the Ontario Professional Planners Institute (OPPI), an affiliate of the Canadian Institute of Planners (CIP), recognizes this day to celebrate the accomplishments of planners and the contribution Planners have made to their communities; and,
- WHEREAS: World Town Planning Day is an opportunity for planners to host and engage in national and local public events such as conferences, walking tours, presentations, and recognize people, projects and development in the field of urban planning that raise awareness about the importance of good planning; and,
