

Downtown Transitional Area


This area serves as a transition between the Riverwest neighborhood and the Downtown core. It serves multiple uses including residential, commercial and some institutional developments as well.

Institutional Area


The narrowest portion of the corridor with limited opportunities for on-street parking and presence of traffic calming treatments to facilitate pedestrian movements.
