The Sunparlour Woodcarvers Club began in 1981 with 32 members. It grew in membership to over 350 carvers. It has held 3 “International Woodcarving Festivals” in Windsor, each with an attendance of over 7,000 people.

Woodcarvers are a breed of their own. Never in a hurry, they take time to do their woodcarvings, to talk to people, to explain techniques, to encourage the novice... in other words, they take time to live in this fast-paced world.

In honour of Windsor’s Centennial, the Sunparlour Woodcarvers Club challenges its members to donate an original carving which, when displayed together, would form a wooden mosaic.

The result of over 40 woodcarvers’ efforts, the finished piece was displayed

at the old Windsor City Hall, before moving to 400 City Hall Square in 2018/2019.
