SET UP INFORMATION – EXHIBITORS

- 1) Set up is on Sunday, April 21st beginning at 8:00 a.m. All exhibitors must be set up by 9:30 a.m. Vehicle access will not be permitted after 9:15 am and before 3:15 pm.
- 2) Vendors are asked to check in at the Information tent and an Earth Day Committee member will show you where to set up your exhibit.
- 3) Tear down can begin after 3:00 p.m.
- 4) This is a waste free event. All food wares must be of an approved material (additional information is available for food vendors). Volunteers will be onsite to operate a waste sorting station. Virtual information sessions will be set up in early April for those that would like to learn more about this initiative.

BOOTH INFORMATION

- 1) There is NO hydro provided for exhibitors. Please inquire if you need hydro.
- 2) All booths are provided with either a 6 ft. or 8 ft. banquet table and two chairs.
- 3) Exhibitors should provide a tablecloth for their 8 ft. banquet table.
- 4) This is a GARBAGE FREE event! Recycling and composting will be available. This applies to food vendors as well. We will have compostable cutlery available for you, if necessary.
