## RE: Notice of Public Information Centre (PIC) Traffic Calming Study – Pillette Road (Tecumseh Road East to Plymouth Drive)


The City of Windsor has received a request for traffic calming in the study area identified. Traffic calming measures are intended to improve conditions for non-motorized users, alter driver behaviour and reduce negative effects of motor vehicle use.

Consultation with the public and review agencies is an essential component of the City of Windsor's Traffic Calming Policy. A Public Information Centre (PIC) is scheduled for Thursday, June 17, 2021, from 6:30 PM to 8:30 PM. All interested stakeholders are invited to attend this drop-in style open house to:

- Meet the Project Team, which includes staff from the City of Windsor as well as from Dillon Consulting Limited.
- Become informed about the traffic calming process.
- Learn about the results of the neighbourhood review.
- Review the draft traffic calming plan.
- Provide feedback and input.

The Project Team is interested in hearing the community's comments, questions and concerns regarding the implementation of traffic calming in the study area. Comments and input gathered from the public and review agencies will be taken into consideration during the subsequent planning and design activities.
