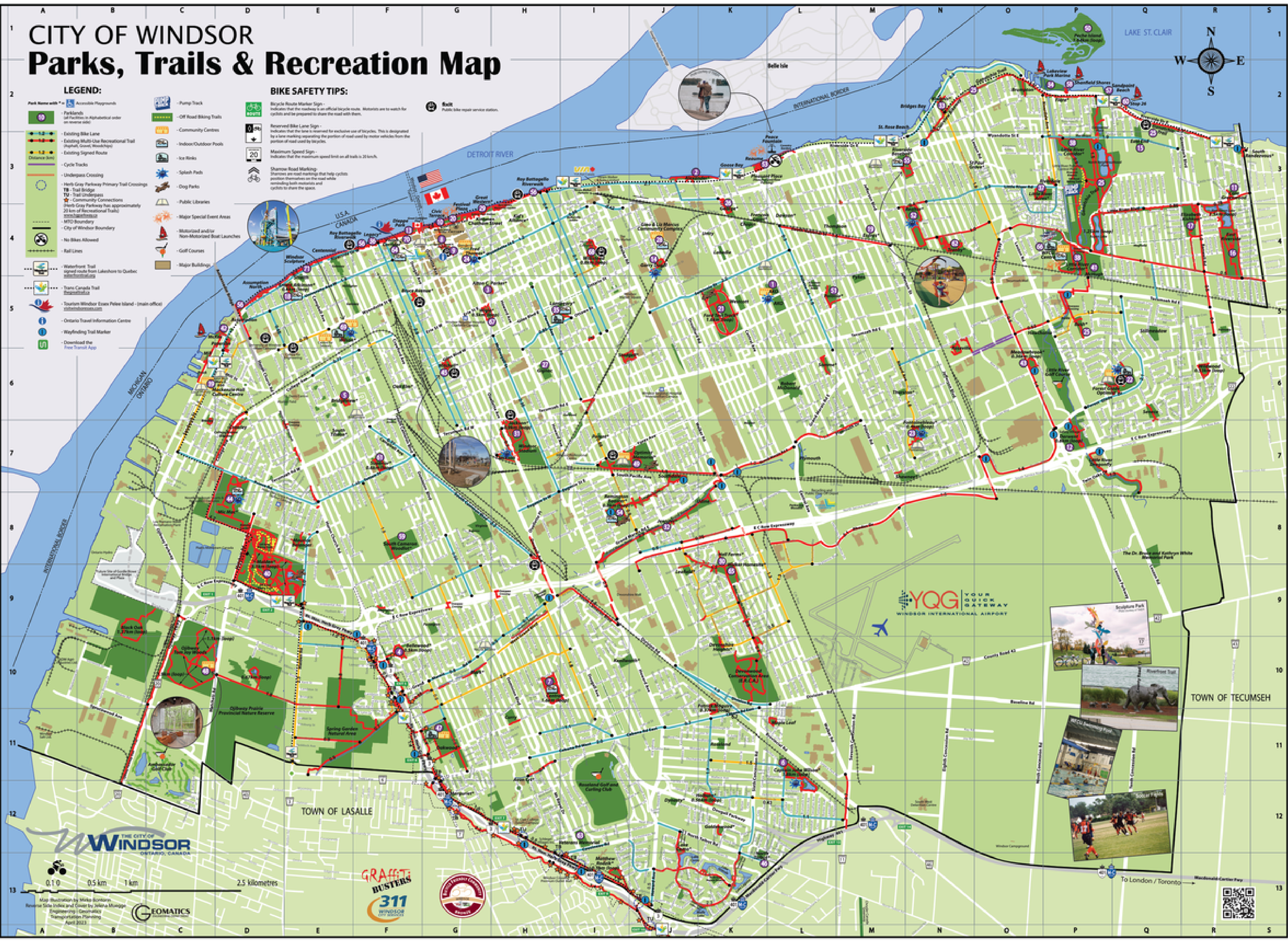

## BIKE SAFETY TIPS:

- Bicycle Route Marker Sign**  
Indicates that the roadway is an official bicycle route. Motorists are to watch for cyclists and be prepared to share the road with them.
- Reversed Bicycle Lane Sign**  
Indicates that the lane is reserved for exclusive use of bicycles. This is designated by a lane marking reserving the portion of road used by motor vehicles from the portion of road used by bicycles.
- Maximum Speed Sign**  
Indicates that the maximum speed limit on all roads is 20 km/h.
- Sharrow Road Marking**  
Sharrows are road markings that help cyclists position themselves on the road while reminding both motorists and cyclists to share the space.

Public bike repair service station.
