He notes the Mayor of Fujisawa has extended an invitation to Mayor Francis and the Official Delegation from Windsor to visit Fujisawa for the 25<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Celebration of Windsor's Twin City to be held from September 28, 2012 to October 1, 2012.
