LICENCE COMMISSIONER'S COMMENTS

The attached applications were received by the Licensing Division on July 18, 2019 from Mr. Khuram Shahzad, Plate Holder of Taxicab #208, and from Mr. Ibrahim Nabhan Ishoaibi for the prospective transfer of Taxicab Plate #208.

REGULATORY AUTHORITY

Schedule 5, Part VII, Section 20.1 through 20.4 of Licensing By-law 137-2007 states:

- "20.1 Except as approved by the Licensing Commission, a taxicab plate holder may not transfer a taxicab plate and associated taxicab plate holder licence for a period of at least five (5) years from the date of issue of the licence.
- 20.2 No taxicab plate holder licence shall be transferred without the approval of the Licensing Commission.
- 20.3 No taxicab plate holder licence shall be transferred until the person to whom the transfer is to be made has first received approval from the Licence Commissioner as a licensee.

- 20.4 Subject to the restrictions herein, taxicab plates numbered 001 to 224 are transferable, provided that:
 - (a) the transferee satisfies the eligibility criteria for inclusion on the Drivers' List;
 - (b) the transferee signs a form of statutory declaration prescribed by the Licence Commissioner;
 - (c) the transferor has completed a written application for the transfer in the prescribed form;
 - (d) the transferee satisfies the requirements of a taxicab plate holder under this By-law, including submitting for inspection the taxicab to which the plate will be affixed;
 - (e) the transferee pays all fees required under this By-law;

and the transferee will receive a taxicab plate holder licence at the time of transfer of the taxicab plate."

Further, Section 21.3 states:

"A taxicab or taxicab wheelchair accessible vehicle plate holder who has held a licence for a minimum of one (l) year may lease the taxicab or taxicab wheelchair accessible vehicle licence on a daily, weekly, monthly or yearly basis provided that:

(a) the lessee is licensed by the City of Windsor as a taxicab driver;

(b) all weekly, monthly or yearly leases are filed with and approved by the Licence Commissioner and shall be subject to such terms and conditions the Licence Commissioner may require;

(c) the amount charged under the lease shall be a fair fee as approved by the Licence Commissioner and no additional charges shall be made against the lessee;

(d) the lease agreement shall include a statement that the leasing agreement is considered null and void in the event that the lessor or lessee, either by written or verbal agreement, sub-leases the taxicab or taxicab wheelchair accessible vehicle or transfers responsibility for the operation of the taxicab or taxicab wheelchair accessible vehicle to a third party;

(e) the lease agreement shall contain a clearly-stated right of the lessor and lessee to early termination of the lease;

(f) where the lessee is a corporation, the lessee shall, at the time at which the lease is filed with the Licence Commissioner in accordance with the provision of this section, file with the Licence Commissioner a form supplied by the Licence Commissioner and a copy of the lessee's articles of incorporation, amendment or amalgamation; and,

(g) the lease term shall be a minimum of twelve (12) months and a maximum of twenty-four (24) months."

BACKGROUND

- July 18, 2019, transfer application and fee was received from Mr. Khuram Shahzad, being Appendix "A"
- July 18, 2019, transferee application for Mr. Ibrahim Nabhan Ishoaibi was submitted, being Appendix "B".
- September 3, 2019, proof of full-time status as a taxicab driver was received from Mr. Ishoaibi

SUMMARY

According to the AMANDA database, Mr. Khuram Shahzad has been the plate holder of taxicab plate #208 annually since 2010 and is therefore compliant with Section 20.1 to Public Vehicle Licensing By-Law 137-2007.

It is being requested that Taxicab Plate #208 be transferred to Mr. Ibrahim Nabhan Ishoaibi, who is currently not a licensed plate holder. Although Mr. Ishoaibi does not hold a current place on the Drivers' List, he has provided proof that he has been employed as a full-time taxicab driver since March 3, 2017, which satisfies the requirements of Section 20.4(a) of Schedule 5.

Mr. Ibrahim Nabhan Ishoaibi must provide:

- (a) Verification of an appropriate vehicle to which he will affix taxicab plate #208, including a valid safety standards certificate
- (b) A completed Plate Holder application and pay the associated fee
- (c) Verification that full compensation has been made to Mr. Khuram Shahzad in consideration of the transfer of taxicab plate #208

RECOMMENDATION

To the Windsor Licensing Commission for decision on the following:

THAT the transfer of Taxicab Plate #208 from Mr. Khuram Shahzad to Mr. Ibrahim Nabhan Ishoaibi **BE APPROVED** with the following conditions:

- i. Mr. Ishoaibi be given thirty (30) days from the date of this decision to submit a vehicle for inspection that complies with Schedule 5 to By-law 137-2007, including a valid safety standards certificate.
- ii. Mr. Ishoaibi must submit a Plate Holder application and pay the applicable fee.
- iii. Mr. Ishoaibi shall provide verification that full compensation has been made to Mr. Shahzad in consideration of the transfer of taxicab plate #208.
- iv. Mr. Ishoaibi shall not lease the plate for a one year period as stated in Schedule 5, Section 21.3 of Licensing By-law 137-2007.

LICENCE COMMISSIONER'S COMMENTS

An application for a Hospitality Food/Liquor Service licence at 6770 Tecumseh Road East, Windsor, ON N8T 1E6 was submitted on March 20, 2019 by Mr. George Dragicevic on behalf of Serbian Centre Ltd. Although the Serbian Centre has been licensed annually since at least 1997, licensing records indicate this application represents a change in ownership.

REGULATORY AUTHORITY

Business Licensing By-Law 395-2004

3.8 Licence - application - subject to approval

Every application will be subject to investigations approvals from such municipal or provincial departments or agencies as the Licence Commissioner deems necessary, or as directed by the Windsor Licensing Commission, including but not limited to: Police Services, Windsor/Essex County Health Unit, Fire and Rescue Services Department, Building and Development Department, Environmental Services Department and Licensing and Enforcement Department.

3.25 Licensing powers - Licence Commissioner - issue or renew

(1) Upon receipt of an application in the prescribed form for a licence or renewal thereof, shall make or cause to be made all investigation required by law and if the investigation disclose any reason to believe that the applicant is not of good character or that the carrying on of the said trade, calling, business or occupation will be likely to result in a breach of the law or be in any way adverse to the public interest, the Licence

Commissioner shall recommend to the Windsor Licensing Commission that it not issue or renew the licence or that it impose conditions on the issuance of a licence, otherwise, the Licence Commissioner shall recommend to the Windsor Licensing Commission that it issue or renew the licence.

3.31 Refusal - suspension - revocation - by Windsor Licensing Commission - hearing

- (1) At the hearing, the Windsor Licensing Commission may suspend, revoke or refuse to issue any licence under this by-law:
 - (a) for any reason that would disentitle the holder to a licence if he/she were an applicant;
 - (b) where the holder of the licence or applicant is in breach of a condition of the licence or of this by-law;
 - (c) if there are reasonable grounds to believe that the statements on the licence application are false;
 - (d) if a report is filed subsequent to the date of the issuance of the licence by any department or agency which provided its approval originally to the issuance of the licence which indicates that a licensed premises no longer complies with any of the provisions of this by-law;
 - (e) upon such grounds as are set out in this by-law;
 - (f) if the applicant has outstanding fines or penalties owing to the municipality or has not paid the required licence application fee;
 - (g) if the conduct or character of the applicant or licensee affords reasonable cause to believe that the applicant or licensee will not carry on or engage in the business in accordance with the law or with honesty and integrity;
 - (h) if the geographic location of the business does not meet land use requirements;
 - (i) if, in the case of a corporate applicant or licensee, the conduct of its officers, directors, employees or agents affords reasonable cause to believe that the business will not be engaged in or carried on in accordance with the law or with honesty and integrity; or
 - (j) if issuing a licence is not in the public interest.

BACKGROUND

- March 20, 2019, Mr. George Dragicevic makes application on behalf of Serbian Centre Ltd. for a Hospitality Food/Liquor Service licence.
- March 26, 2019, Ken Passa, Supervisor of Environmental Quality enters the first note in a series of an ongoing history of non-compliance with respect to the applicant maintaining the establishment's grease trap:
 - Mar 26, 2019 Grease trap full of hardened grease, cleaned last year.
 Frequency of cleaning needs to be increased.
 - O March 27, 2019 Grease traps require cleaning.
 - o April 5, 2019 Grease trap requires repair.
 - o July 11, 2019 On Hold
- June 14, 2019, a letter is sent by Licensing to Mr. Dragicevic's attention advising him that we had been notified by the Pollution Control Department that an approval was not granted following their inspections. A request was made that he contact the Pollution Control Department and have all deficiencies corrected by July 5, 2019.
- July 16, 2019, an email is sent by Licensing to the Supervisor of Environmental Quality, requesting a status update. The Supervisors indicates, "The grease trap has not been repaired yet. The Manager; Dan Dobrich, stated that they are planning to get a new trap to replace the rusted one. There was a thick layer of grease on both

get a new trap to replace the rusted one. There was a thick layer of grease on both traps, he stated they were cleaned 3 weeks ago. We have advised them the traps need to be cleaned more often."

SUMMARY

Administration recommends to the Windsor Licensing Commission that it refuse to issue a Hospitality Food/Liquor Service licence to Serbian Centre Ltd. at 6770 Tecumseh Road East, Windsor, ON N8T 1E6. It is not in the public interest to issue a licence since they have ongoing issues with the Public Works Department and are consistently failing to maintain their grease trap. Should the Windsor Licensing Commission decide to refuse to issue the licence, the applicant would be required to correct any outstanding deficiencies identified by the Public Works Department, re-apply for their licence and pay the applicable fees.

RECOMMENDATION:

THAT the Windsor Licensing Commission **REFUSE TO ISSUE** Hospitality Food/Liquor Service application #19 190055, submitted by Mr. George Dragicevic on behalf of Serbian Centre Ltd. at 6770 Tecumseh Road East, Windsor, ON N8T 1E6.

LICENCE COMMISSIONER'S COMMENTS

An application for an Automobile Service Station - Car Wash licence at 1451 Lauzon Road, Windsor, ON N8S 3N2 was submitted on February 4, 2019 by Mr. Ben Scurto on behalf of Precision Car Care & Auto Wash Ltd. Licensing records show that Precision Car Care & Auto Wash Ltd. has been licensed intermittently at 1451 Lauzon Road from at least 1997. However, the records also show that this business has been operating unlicensed since 2013. In 2015, By-law Enforcement issued a Provincial Offence Notice for operation without a valid business licence. The charge was not disputed and the fine was paid in full.

REGULATORY AUTHORITY

Business Licensing By-Law 395-2004

3.8 Licence - application - subject to approval

Every application will be subject to investigations approvals from such municipal or provincial departments or agencies as the Licence Commissioner deems necessary, or as directed by the Windsor Licensing Commission, including but not limited to: Police Services, Windsor/Essex County Health Unit, Fire and Rescue Services Department, Building and Development Department, Environmental Services Department and Licensing and Enforcement Department.

3.25 Licensing powers - Licence Commissioner - issue or renew

(1) Upon receipt of an application in the prescribed form for a licence or renewal thereof, shall make or cause to be made all investigation required by law and if the investigation disclose any reason to believe that the applicant is not of good character or that the carrying on of the said trade, calling, business or occupation will be likely to result in a breach of the law or be in any way adverse to the public interest, the Licence Commissioner shall recommend to the Windsor Licensing Commission that it not issue or renew the licence or that it impose conditions on the issuance of a licence, otherwise, the Licence Commissioner shall recommend to the Windsor Licensing Commission that it issue or renew the licence.

3.31 Refusal - suspension - revocation - by Windsor Licensing Commission - hearing

- (1) At the hearing, the Windsor Licensing Commission may suspend, revoke or refuse to issue any licence under this by-law:
 - (a) for any reason that would disentitle the holder to a licence if he/she were an applicant;
 - (b) where the holder of the licence or applicant is in breach of a condition of the licence or of this by-law;
 - (c) if there are reasonable grounds to believe that the statements on the licence application are false;
 - (d) if a report is filed subsequent to the date of the issuance of the licence by any department or agency which provided its approval originally to the issuance of the licence which indicates that a licensed premises no longer complies with any of the provisions of this by-law;
 - (e) upon such grounds as are set out in this by-law;
 - (f) if the applicant has outstanding fines or penalties owing to the municipality or has not paid the required licence application fee;
 - (g) if the conduct or character of the applicant or licensee affords reasonable cause to believe that the applicant or licensee will not carry on or engage in the business in accordance with the law or with honesty and integrity;
 - (h) if the geographic location of the business does not meet land use requirements;
 - (i) if, in the case of a corporate applicant or licensee, the conduct of its officers, directors, employees or agents affords reasonable cause to believe that the business will not be engaged in or carried on in accordance with the law or with honesty and integrity; or
 - (j) if issuing a licence is not in the public interest.

BACKGROUND

- February 4, 2019, Mr. Ben Scurto makes application on behalf of Precision Car Care & Auto Wash Ltd. for an Automobile Service Station Car Wash licence.
- March 18, 2019, Ken Passa, Supervisor of Environmental Quality enters the first note in a series which details an ongoing history of non-compliance with respect to the applicant maintaining the establishment's interceptor:
 - Mar 18, 2019 All stages of interceptor full of sludge, advised to clean. Reinspect
 - o April 5, 2019 Interceptor has not been cleaned.
- April 8, 2019, a letter is sent by Licensing to Mr. Scurto's attention advising him that we had been notified by the Pollution Control Department that an approval was not granted following their inspections. A request was made that he contact the Pollution Control Department and correct deficiencies by April 23, 2019.

- April 26, 2019, an email is received by Ken Passa stating that he would contact the applicant regarding re-inspection the following week.
- July 23, 2019, an updated note is entered by Pollution Control:
 - Oil interceptor, 3rd stage is full of sludge and has a layer of oil on its surface. Left a message with owner to have the interceptor pumped out.
- July 23, 2019, a second letter is sent by Licensing to Mr. Scurto's attention advising that Pollution Control was still unable to grant an approval. A request was made that he contact the Pollution Control Department and correct deficiencies by August 6, 2019.
- August 12, 2019, the first in a series of additional notes is entered by Pollution Control:
 - o Aug 12, 2019 Business owner called K.Passa and stated he would have the interceptor pumped out & cleaned the week of Aug 12 16, 2019
 - o Aug 20, 2019 Inspected the interceptor and found that it had not been cleaned and was in worse condition than last inspection.
- August 20, 2019, an email is received by Licensing from the Supervisor of Environmental Quality, requesting the file be forwarded to the Windsor Licensing Commission.

SUMMARY

Administration recommends to the Windsor Licensing Commission that it refuse to issue an Automobile Service Station - Car Wash licence to Precision Car Care & Auto Wash Ltd. at 1451 Lauzon Road, Windsor, ON N8S 3N2. It is not in the public interest to issue a licence since they have ongoing issues with the Public Works Department and are consistently failing to maintain their interceptor. Should the Windsor Licensing Commission decide to refuse to issue the licence, the applicant would be required to correct any outstanding deficiencies identified by the Public Works Department, re-apply for their licence and pay the applicable fees.

RECOMMENDATION:
