LICENCE COMMISSIONER'S COMMENTS

Mr. Walter Bezzina, Power of Attorney for Mr. Feisal Ibrahim, Plate Holder of Taxicab #009, submitted the attached application to the Licensing Division on March 19, 2015 for the prospective transfer to Mr. Mohammad Kashash.

REGULATORY AUTHORITY

Schedule 5, Part VII, Section 20.1 through 20.4 of Licensing By-law 137-2007 states:

"20.1 Except as approved by the Licensing Commission, a taxicab plate holder may not transfer a taxicab plate and associated taxicab plate holder licence for a period of at least five (5) years from the date of issue of the licence.

20.2 No taxicab plate holder licence shall be transferred without the approval of the Licensing

Commission.

- 20.3 No taxicab plate holder licence shall be transferred until the person to whom the transfer is to be made has first received approval from the Licence Commissioner as a licensee.
- 20.4 Subject to the restrictions herein, taxicab plates numbered 001 to 224 are transferable, provided that:
 - (a) the transferee satisfies the eligibility criteria for inclusion on the Drivers' List;
 - (b) the transferee signs a form of statutory declaration prescribed by the Licence Commissioner;
 - (c) the transferor has completed a written application for the transfer in the prescribed form;
 - (d) the transferee satisfies the requirements of a taxicab plate holder under this By-law, including submitting for inspection the taxicab to which the plate will be affixed;
 - (e) the transferee pays all fees required under this By-law;

and the transferee will receive a taxicab plate holder licence at the time of transfer of the taxicab plate."

Further, Section 21.3 states:

"A taxicab or taxicab wheelchair accessible vehicle plate holder who has held a licence for a minimum of one (l) year may lease the taxicab or taxicab wheelchair accessible vehicle licence on a daily, weekly, monthly or yearly basis provided that:

- (a) the lessee is licensed by the City of Windsor as a taxicab driver;
- (b) all weekly, monthly or yearly leases are filed with and approved by the Licence Commissioner and shall be subject to such terms and conditions the Licence Commissioner may require;
- (c) the amount charged under the lease shall be a fair fee as approved by the Licence Commissioner and no additional charges shall be made against the lessee;
- (d) the lease agreement shall include a statement that the leasing agreement is considered null and void in the event that the lessor or lessee, either by written or verbal agreement, sub-leases the taxicab or taxicab wheelchair accessible vehicle or transfers responsibility for the operation of the taxicab or taxicab wheelchair accessible vehicle to a third party;
- (e) the lease agreement shall contain a clearly-stated right of the lessor and lessee to early termination of the lease;
- (f) where the lessee is a corporation, the lessee shall, at the time at which the lease is filed with the Licence Commissioner in accordance with the provision of this section, file with the Licence Commissioner a form supplied by the Licence Commissioner and a copy of the lessee's articles of incorporation, amendment or amalgamation; and,
- (g) the lease term shall be a minimum of twelve (12) months and a maximum of twenty-four (24) months."

BACKGROUND

- March 19, 2015, transfer application, copy of Power of Attorney and fee was received from Mr. Walter Bezzina, Power of Attorney for Mr. Feisal Ibrahim, being Appendices "A" and "B"
- March 30, 2015, transferee application and proof of full-time employment status for Mr. Mohammad Kashash was submitted, being Appendices "C" and "D".

SUMMARY

Mr. Feisal Ibrahim has been a taxi plate holder since June 22, 2012. Section 20.1 of Schedule 5 to Public Vehicle Licensing By-Law 137-2007 states that a plate may not be transferred for a period of at least five (5) years from the date of issue of the licence unless otherwise approved by the Windsor Licensing Commission. Mr. Walter Bezzina, Power of Attorney for Mr. Ibrahim, has stated that Mr. Ibrahim is requesting to transfer his plate prior to the fixed five years due to the fact that a family emergency has occurred. As a result, Mr. Ibrahim has been required to travel to Ethiopia for an undetermined amount of time.

It is being requested that Taxicab Plate #009 be transferred to Mr. Mohammad Kashash. Mr. Kashash is currently not a licensed plate holder. Although Mr. Kashash is not on the Drivers' List, Licensing records indicate he has been licensed as a taxicab driver since 2012 and he has provided proof that he has been employed as a full-time taxicab driver since October 12, 2012, satisfying the requirements of Section 20.4(a) of Schedule 5 to Public Vehicle Licensing By-Law 137-2007.

The Windsor Licensing Commission has been granted the authority to act on the application in any manner that it deems fit.

RECOMMENDATION

To the Windsor Licensing Commission for decision on the following:

- i. **THAT** the transfer of Taxicab Plate #009 from Mr. Feisal Ibrahim to Mr. Mohammad Kashash **BE APPROVED** with the following conditions:
 - Mr. Mohammad Kashash be given thirty (30) days from the date of this decision to submit a vehicle for inspection that complies with Schedule 5 to By-law 137-2007.
 - Mr. Mohammad Kashash must submit a Plate Holder application and pay the applicable fee.
- Mr. Mohammad Kashash shall not lease the plate for a one year period as stated in Schedule 5, Section 21.3 of Licensing By-law 137-2007.

3.8 Licence - application - subject to approval

Every application will be subject to investigations approvals from such municipal or provincial departments or agencies as the Licence Commissioner deems necessary, or as directed by the Windsor Licensing Commission, including but not limited to: Police Services, Windsor/Essex County Health Unit, Fire and Rescue Services Department, Building and Development Department, Environmental Services Department and Licensing and Enforcement Department.

3.25 Licensing powers – Licence Commissioner – issue or renew

(1) Upon receipt of an application in the prescribed form for a licence or renewal thereof, shall make or cause to be made all investigation required by law and if the investigation disclose any reason to believe that the applicant is not of good character

or that the carrying on of the said trade, calling, business or occupation will be likely to result in a breach of the law or be in any way adverse to the public interest, the Licence Commissioner shall recommend to the Windsor Licensing Commission that it not issue or renew the licence or that it impose conditions on the issuance of a licence, otherwise, the Licence Commissioner shall recommend to the Windsor Licensing Commission that it issue or renew the licence.

3.31 Refusal - suspension - revocation - by Windsor Licensing Commission - hearing

- (1) At the hearing, the Windsor Licensing Commission may suspend, revoke or refuse to issue any licence under this by-law:
 - (a) for any reason that would disentitle the holder to a licence if he/she were an applicant;
 - (b) where the holder of the licence or applicant is in breach of a condition of the licence or of this by-law;
 - (c) if there are reasonable grounds to believe that the statements on the licence application are false;
 - (d) if a report is filed subsequent to the date of the issuance of the licence by any department or agency which provided its approval originally to the issuance of the licence which indicates that a licensed premises no longer complies with any of the provisions of this by-law;
 - (e) upon such grounds as are set out in this by-law;
 - (f) if the applicant has outstanding fines or penalties owing to the municipality or has not paid the required licence application fee;
 - (g) if the conduct or character of the applicant or licensee affords reasonable cause to believe that the applicant or licensee will not carry on or engage in the business in accordance with the law or with honesty and integrity;
 - (h) if the geographic location of the business does not meet land use requirements;
 - (i) if, in the case of a corporate applicant or licensee, the conduct of its officers, directors, employees or agents affords reasonable cause to believe that the business will not be engaged in or carried on in accordance with the law or with honesty and integrity; or
 - (j) if issuing a licence is not in the public interest.

BACKGROUND

- March 20, 2014, Mr. Remo Agostino made application for an Entertainment Lounge licence on behalf of 1656901 Ontario Inc.
- January 20, 2015, an inspection was scheduled with Fire Prevention Officer Lynne Pretli however, was rescheduled for January 26, 2015 at the request of the applicant.
- January 26, 2015, Fire Prevention Officer Pretli attended the premises at 315 Ouellette Avenue to conduct an inspection and found the applicant was not present and therefore, an inspection was unable to be conducted.
- February 13, 2015, Fire Prevention Officer Pretli re-attended the premises at 315 Ouellette Avenue and found the business to be in violation of the Fire Code.
- February 13, 2015, Fire Prevention Officer Pretli issued an order on the property.
- March 3, 2015, Fire Prevention Officer Pretli noted that the applicant had not supplied her with the documents requested of him in the February 13, 2015 inspection and recommended that a report be sent to the Windsor Licensing Commission.

- March 9, 2015, a letter was sent to the applicant by the Licensing office advising him
 that the department had been notified by Windsor Fire & Rescue that an approval was
 not granted following their inspections. A request was made that he contact Fire
 Prevention Officer Pretli by March 24, 2015 to address the issues found in previous
 inspections.
- March 9, 2015, Fire Prevention Officer Pretli re-attended the premises and found that not all deficiencies had been corrected and provided the applicant with an additional two weeks to comply.
- March 19, 2015, Fire Prevention Officer Pretli received a phone call from Windsor Fire Equipment stating that they had been retained to complete repairs on the emergency lighting and they would forward the subsequent reports to her by the end of the day on March 27, 2015.
- March 27, 2015, Fire Prevention Officer Pretli received a phone call from the Manager of The Boom Boom Room stating that he would not be able to meet her for a re-inspection until Wednesday of the following week. Officer Pretli advised that the inspection could not wait that long and requested that the documentation be available for inspection on Monday.
- April 10, 2015, Fire Prevention Officer Pretli left a voicemail message for the Manager at 8:45am stating that she would like to conduct an inspection at 3:00pm that same day. She received no return call and then recommended that a report be sent to the Windsor Licensing Commission.

SUMMARY

Administration recommends to the Windsor Licensing Commission, that it refuse to renew an Entertainment Lounge licence to the applicant at 315 Ouellette Avenue. It is not in the public interest to issue a licence since they have outstanding issues with Windsor Fire & Rescue that they have failed to correct. Should the Windsor Licensing Commission decide to refuse the application for this licence, the applicant would be required to correct outstanding deficiencies identified by Windsor Fire & Rescue, re-apply for their licence and pay the applicable fees.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the application for an Entertainment Lounge licence submitted by 1656901 Ontario Inc. o/a The Boom Boom Room at 315 Ouellette Avenue **BE REFUSED**.
