## LICENCE COMMISSIONER'S COMMENTS

A new application for two Livery Vehicle licences was submitted on May 26, 2017 by Mr. Dhruv R. Jain of Emm Dee Group, 3371 Sandwich Street, Apt. 308, Windsor. The Licensing Division has no past records for this business.

Currently there are 5 Class "D" Livery Vehicle licensed in the City of Windsor.

## REGULATORY AUTHORITY

The pertinent sections of Schedule 3 to By-law 137-2007 relating to this application state:

- "2.1 The following limit on the number of licences shall be established and reviewed by the Licensing Commission from time to time:
  - (a) Class B Limousine
     (b) Class C Executive
     (c) Class D Van
     (d) Class E Pedicab
     (e) Class F Horse Drawn Carriage
     25 units
     15 units
     10 units
     12 units"
- "4.1 Applicants for livery plate holder licenses in the first instance shall provide to the License Commissioner for consideration by the Licensing Commission:

- (a) type and number of vehicles to be operated;
- (b) details of the nature of the operation;
- (c) market studies or other information to justify the need for the service within the current marketplace, including details of any specific contracts for the service:
- (d) an assessment of the impact of the proposed service on existing "for hire" transportation services in the municipality; and,
- (e) rate structure proposed for the service for comparison with existing, competing services."
- "4.2 In addition to the requirements in 4.1, as may be applicable, no livery vehicle plate and associated livery plate holder licence shall be issued under this By-law until the following requirements have been met:
  - (b) The applicant shall file with the Licence Commissioner evidence of ownership of such livery vehicle and proof that the livery vehicle to be licensed under this By-law has a valid vehicle permit issued under the Highway Traffic Act and is either registered in the name of the applicant or leased to the applicant;
  - (e) the applicant shall file with the Licence Commissioner a safety standards certificate issued within 30 days of the date of the applicant's application;"
- "9.1 Every applicant for a livery vehicle plate holder licence shall file with the Licence Commissioner either a copy of the insurance policy or a certificate of insurance in respect of the livery vehicle which insurance shall meet the following requirements:
  - (a) issuance by an insurer duly authorized to issue insurance within the Province of Ontario;
  - (b) for each livery vehicle, liability coverage is in the amount of not less than THREE MILLION DOLLARS (\$3,000,000.00) for personal injury or property damage arising out of any one accident or occurrence;
  - (c) it shall not be cancelled by the insurer until after fifteen (15) days written notice of such cancellation is given to the Licence Commissioner; and,
  - (d) the owner of the livery vehicle shall be named as the insured and all insured livery vehicles shall be listed and described."
- "10.9 No Class D livery vehicle shall be more than seven (7) model years in age."

## **SUMMARY**

Currently there are 5 Class D Livery Vehicles licensed in the City of Windsor. Therefore, we are within the 30 vehicle limit contained in By-Law 137-2007.

Mr. Jain and Mr. Singh have purchased one of the two vehicles they are requesting licenses for, that vehicle being a 2012 Dodge Caravan (V.I.N. 2C4RDGBG3CR334659). A second vehicle similar in model as a Dodge Caravan will be purchased upon approval of this application. The applicants have been made aware that should their applications be approved, they must satisfy all requirements detailed in Schedule 3 to By-Law 137-2007 for both vehicles.

As noted in the regulation section, the Licensing Commission must review all new applications. The applicant has agreed to comply with all the requirements listed in Schedule 3 of Public Vehicle Licensing By-Law 137-2007 to the satisfaction of the Licence Commissioner. Therefore, it is being recommended for approval.

## RECOMMENDATION:

THAT the livery vehicle plate holder applications, submitted by Mr. Dhruv R. Jain & Mr. Mandeep Singh o/a Emm Dee Group, 3371 Sandwich Street, Apt. #308, Windsor, to operate two (2) Class D –Livery Vehicle **BE APPROVED** with the following conditions:

- Mr. Jain and Mr. Singh be given sixty (60) days from the date of this decision to submit two vehicles that comply with Schedule 3 to By-law 137-2007
- The second vehicle must not be more than ten (10) model years in age
- The applicant must submit proof of ownership, valid Safety Standards certificates and insurance for both vehicles, satisfactory to Sections 4.2 and 9.1 of Schedule 3 to By-Law 137-2007
- The vehicles must submit to and pass an inspection by the By-Law Enforcement Unit

## Market Research

Most University students get a job through various employment agencies like Personnel by Pro-Staff, Renaissance Personnel, The Job Shoppe, Modern Staffing, etc. The job locations offered by most of these agencies are not present on major bus routes. Majority of the students work at greenhouse farms in Leamington. The only bus service that is being provided by "Personnel by Pro-Staff' is for a greenhouse farm called Mastronardi Sunset in Leamington. It picks up and drops people from The Assumption Church near the University on Huron Church Rd. Workers find it inconvenient to reach the particular bus stop due to the inclement weather especially at odd times. It is a hectic and time consuming process and sometimes leads to cancellation of shifts for the workers as they are not able to reach the bus stop on time. Both the part-time and full-time workers are suffering due to this.

The livery plate holder license issued to The EMM DEE GROUP will ensure that students do not have to worry about the logistics of their jobs in or around Windsor. We will charge the particular shift of workers on an individual basis for a return trip. This will make it affordable for the workers as the shifts are usually on a continuously rotating basis and hiring a cab to go such long distances is not feasible. All of the above ensures the business model to be practical, economical, profitable and secure. This will be a one of a kind transportation model targeted at students who are looking to earn money by working part-time.

The idea of this business model struck when one of the partner's (Dhruv R Jain) roommate used to work at Mastronardi Sunset in Leamington, ON and he used to give her a ride to work. She and her colleagues requested Dhruv if he could give them a ride as well and they were willing to pay for it. After talking to several people and attending orientations at various employment agencies, he realized that this could turn into a profitable business model.

Most of the students were working at Mastronardi Sunset (vegetable packaging job) till last year. This year new people have been added to the work force and are working at a new greenhouse farm (general labor) called Mastron. With growing number of jobs available due to new companies and greenhouse farms, there is a huge scope of expansion as well. People with personal cars have made this a side business which is risky since the liability of passengers is not covered. Most of them are not aware of this fact.

One of the partners (Mandeep Singh) has a registered van which adheres with the bylaws and will be transferred to the company's name as soon as the permit is issued. Also, a second van will be purchased and registered in the name of the company keeping in mind the bylaws. As the vill be purchased a company will grow, more very customers. 
