


LITTLE RIVER CHANNEL IMPROVEMENTS VIA RAIL TO LAUZON ROAD MUNICIPAL CLASS ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT

NOTICE OF STUDY COMMENCEMENT AND PUBLIC INFORMATION CENTRE No. 1

The City of Windsor has initiated a Schedule B Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (Class EA) for the preliminary study and design for improvements to the Little River channel corridor from the VIA Rail Tracks southerly to its crossing under Lauzon Road.

The goal of the proposed design is to create a more sustainable river corridor while enhancing the ecological and aesthetic functions of the existing channel.

The City is hosting a Public Information Centre (PIC) to present and discuss the needs and justification for improvements, existing study area conditions, and assessment of alternative solutions and design concepts. Consultation is an integral part of the class EA process and members of the public, agencies, and other interested persons are invited to participate in the upcoming PIC.
