Hello Everyone,

Earth Day will be a zero-waste event. New this year, we will have a designated waste drop off (Zero Waste Drop Off), where volunteers will be sorting waste to ensure that everything goes where it should.

We ask that you ensure containers are either recyclable or certified compostable and utensils are certified compostable. Some criteria on what to look for and what to avoid when considering these supplies are:

Compostable	Recyclable	Avoid
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ ASTM D6400 Certified: This standard applies to products made from plastics that are designed to be composted in commercial composting facilities. ✓ ASTM D6868 Certified: This standard covers laminated paper and sugarcane (bagasse) items that are designed to be composted in commercial composting facilities. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Clamshells, ✓ Red solo cups ✓ Aluminum foil, trays, or pie plates, etc. ✓ Anything paper based 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✗ Styrofoam ✗ Plastic bags ✗ Plastic utensils ✗ Plastic Straws
