BY - LAW NUMBER 519

A BY-LAW FOR PROHIBITING SPITTING IN PUBLIC PLACES IN THE CITY OF WINDSOR

Passed the 3rd day of April 1945.

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to prohibit spitting on sidewalks and other public places within the City of Windsor;

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the City of Windsor enacts as follows -

1. That no person shall spit on the sidewalk of any street, alley or public place, nor in the passageway, stairway or entrance of any building used by the public, nor on the floor of any building, hall, room or place to which the public resort, nor in any public conveyance within the City of Windsor.

2. Every person who contravenes any of the provisions of this by-law (Chapter) is guilty of an offence and shall, upon conviction thereof, forfeit and pay a penalty of not more than Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000), exclusive of costs and every such fine is recoverable under the Provincial Offences Act. (amended B/L 10277, May 22/90)

3. That By-law Number 1114 of the former City of Windsor, passed the 11th day of April, 1904 be and the same is hereby repealed.

4. That this by-law shall come into force on the day of the final passing thereof.
