The office of my colleague the Honourable Catherine McKenna, Minister of Environment and Climate Change, forwarded to me on June 3, 2016, a copy of your letter concerning the Windsor Hum. I am very sympathetic to the concerns of city of Windsor residents.

As noted in the study results released in May 2014 in order to determine the source of the Windsor Hum precisely, further work must also take place on the U.S. side of the river. Since the release of the study results, Canadian officials have continued to follow up with key interlocutors, first meeting with officials from the city of River Rouge and representatives from U.S. Steel in the summer of 2014.

Future progress is in part dependent on the cooperation of U.S. interlocutors, and Canadian officials continue to raise concerns with them.
