Mr. Dave Krndija is present on behalf of 1710717 Ontario Ltd. o/a Rockhead Pub.

C. Robertson states on August 22, 2014, the Supervisor of Environmental Quality attended the property and stated "*Two 45 gallon Cs drums waste grease (need to secure drums). Catch basin in alley about 40' from waste grease containers. Grease trap requires cleaning*". As of September 22, 2014, the grease trap had not been cleaned and the grease bins were not secure.

Mr. Krndija states the grease trap was cleaned by a licensed plumber. He questions what measures are required to secure the waste grease drums.

In response to a question asked by Councillor Sleiman regarding why Mr. Krndija neglected to contact the Building Department relating to correcting the deficiencies, Mr. Krndija responds he didn't realize his licence would be revoked over "grease".

Councillor Gignac asks if there are standards regarding securing the waste grease drums. K. Passa responds the drums must be secured against a wall to ensure the drums does not topple over and spill into the storm sewer.

(c) Excess Metals Ltd. – Salvage Yard

Lia Bernachi o/a Excess Metals is present to speak to the matter. Also present are Jason Shuttleworth and Richard Hansen.

C. Robertson advises Lia Bernachi o/a Excess Metals has previously been licensed to operate a Salvage Yard, with approved conditions to wreck motor vehicles, as a sole proprietor at this location since 2008. He states this is a new application as Ms. Bernachi has decided to incorporate her business.

In response to a question by Councillor Gignac regarding if Ms. Bernachi intends to upgrade the dirt yard to a different surface, Ms. Bernachi responds any potholes have been filled in with gravel and further, that the property is leased.

Mr. Richard Hansen expresses concern with mud and glass along the road.

Ms. Bernachi indicates most of the trucks that attend the business utilize the washing station before leaving the property.

Councillor Gignac is concerned the volume of the business will increase and asks what is allowed under a salvage yard classification. C. Robertson remarks he cannot anticipate if the volume of the business will increase. He states the salvage yard classification allows for the crushing of vehicles into a small compact cube.

LICENCE COMMISSIONER’S COMMENTS

Wheelchair Accessible Taxicab Plate #224 is currently licensed as a 2007 Dodge Caravan. An application has been submitted by Javanshir Abdoulrahmanpour on behalf of the plate holder, 1681207 Ontario Ltd. o/a Canadian Checker Cab, to replace that vehicle with a 2010 Dodge Caravan.

REGULATORY AUTHORITY

Public Vehicle Licensing By-Law 137-2007

Part II - Application

2. No person shall:

(a) carry on business as a taxicab plate holder or taxicab wheelchair accessible plate holder (**Added by By-law 135-2010 dated August 23, 2010**); without first obtaining the requisite licence from the Licensing Commission. (**Amended by By-law 135-2010 dated August 23, 2010.**)

Schedule 5, Part V – Taxicabs, Insurance and Equipment

11.3 Taxicab and Taxicab Wheelchair Accessible Vehicles

Every taxicab or taxicab wheelchair accessible vehicle plate holder and taxicab driver shall

maintain the interior and exterior of the taxicab and taxicab wheelchair accessible vehicle in a clean and tidy condition.

- (a) Interior maintenance shall include but not be limited to:
- i) keeping the interior surfaces free from all dust, dirt, grease, oil, adhesive residue and any other substance that can be transferred onto the person, clothing or possessions of a passenger;
 - ii) keeping the interior free of all waste paper, cans, garbage or any other item not necessary or commonly ancillary to the operation of the motor vehicle;
 - iii) keeping the interior free of noxious substances;
 - iv) keeping the interior free of excess wear, including tears and cigarette burns in the upholstery;
 - v) keeping the interior in a dry condition;
 - vi) keeping the interior in good general repair;
 - vii) ensuring all seat belt assemblies are in working order;
 - viii) ensuring all side windows open and close;
 - ix) ensuring all seats are securely mounted in position and are capable of being adjusted; and,
 - x) maintaining a working dome light.
- (b) Exterior maintenance shall include but shall not be limited to:
- i) keeping the exterior free from all dust, dirt, grease, oil, adhesive residue and any other item that can be transferred onto the person, clothing or possessions of a passenger, except water or snow;
 - ii) keeping the exterior in good general repair;
 - iii) maintaining the exterior free from body damage;
 - iv) maintaining all fenders, grilles or molding, with none removed or missing;
 - v) ensuring that the doors and trunk lid close and latch securely;
 - vi) ensuring all door handles and catches are in good repair;
 - vii) maintaining the paint or finish in good general condition; and
 - viii) ensuring the vehicle has four matching hubcaps.

Vehicular Standards

14.8 No taxicab plate holder licence shall be issued for any vehicle being brought into use as a taxicab for the first time, which is more than four (4) model years old from the current model year without the approval of the Licensing Commission. By example, August 31st, 2009 means the model year is 2009. By further example, a vehicle seeking to become a taxi should be a 2009, 2008, 2007 or 2006 i.e. no more than four (4) years old as at August 31, 2009 through August 31, 2010 when a 2010, 2009, 2008, 2007 would be permissible without approval of the Licensing Commission. **(Added By-law 152-2010 dated September 27, 2010)**

14.10 For the purpose of this By-law, the age of a vehicle shall be determined from August 31st of the model year of said vehicle. The current model year as at August 31st in any year is the calendar year as at August 31st in any year. **(Added By-law 152-2010 dated September 27, 2010)**

BACKGROUND

- November 28, 2014, Mr. Javanshir Abdoulrahmanpour makes application for a Taxicab Vehicle Replacement on behalf of 1681207 Ontario Ltd for Wheelchair Accessible plate #224.
- The vehicle that is currently licensed is a 2007 Dodge Caravan, V.I.N. 1D4GP25R37B164535, which is due to be replaced prior to August 31, 2015.
- The replacement vehicle is a 2010 Dodge Caravan, V.I.N. 2D4RN4DE1AR265493, which according to Schedule 5, Section 14.8, requires the approval of the Windsor Licensing Commission prior to entering service.
- A search of the AMANDA Licensing database shows that this vehicle has not been previously licensed to operate as a taxicab in the City of Windsor.
- December 9, 2014, By-Law Enforcement Officer Elizabeth Culmone completes a fitness inspection of the vehicle.
- Officer Culmone states in her report that the vehicle is in good to very good condition.

SUMMARY

The applicant has fully complied with the application process and upon reviewing the report and photos submitted by By-Law Enforcement, Administration supports the recommendation to approve the application for a Taxicab Vehicle Replacement for Wheelchair Accessible Taxicab Plate #224. See Appendix "D".

RECOMMENDATION:

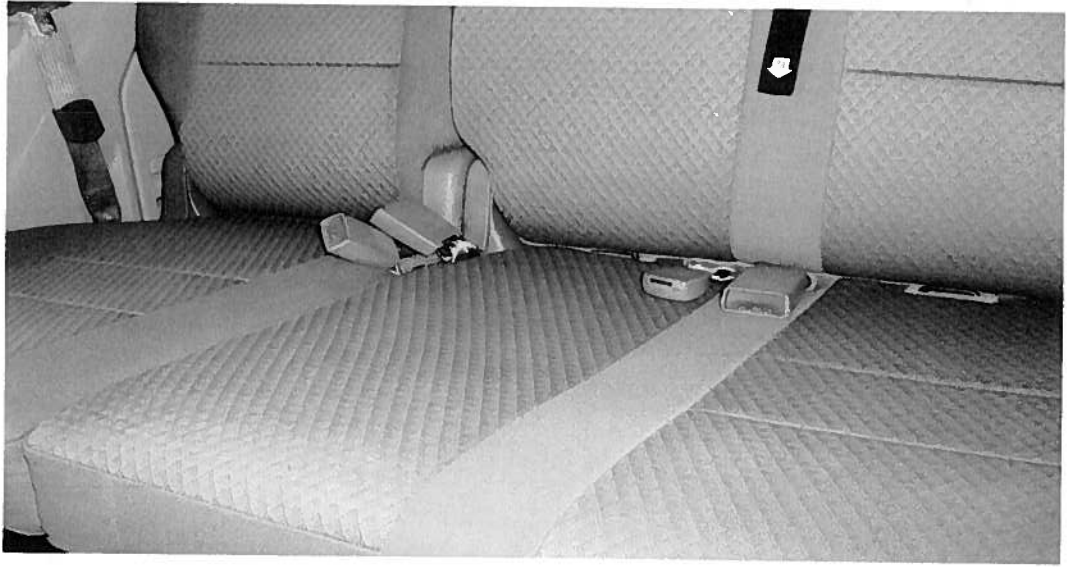
