LICENCE COMMISSIONER'S COMMENTS

Mr. Henry Lesperance, Plate Holder of Taxicab #173, submitted the attached application to the Licensing Division on October 15, 2015 for the prospective transfer to Mr. Walid El-Haj.

REGULATORY AUTHORITY

Schedule 5, Part VII, Section 20.1 through 20.4 of Licensing By-law 137-2007 states:

"20.1 Except as approved by the Licensing Commission, a taxicab plate holder may not transfer a taxicab plate and associated taxicab plate holder licence for a period of at least five (5) years from the date of issue of the licence.

20.2 No taxicab plate holder licence shall be transferred without the approval of the Licensing Commission.

20.3 No taxicab plate holder licence shall be transferred until the person to whom the transfer is to be made has first received approval from the Licence Commissioner as a licensee.

20.4 Subject to the restrictions herein, taxicab plates numbered 001 to 224 are transferable, provided that:

- (a) the transferee satisfies the eligibility criteria for inclusion on the Drivers' List;
- (b) the transferee signs a form of statutory declaration prescribed by the Licence Commissioner;
- (c) the transferor has completed a written application for the transfer in the prescribed form;
- (d) the transferee satisfies the requirements of a taxicab plate holder under this By-law, including submitting for inspection the taxicab to which the plate will be affixed;
- (e) the transferee pays all fees required under this By-law;

and the transferee will receive a taxicab plate holder licence at the time of transfer of the taxicab plate."

Further, Section 21.3 states:

"A taxicab or taxicab wheelchair accessible vehicle plate holder who has held a licence for a minimum of one (1) year may lease the taxicab or taxicab wheelchair accessible vehicle licence on a daily, weekly, monthly or yearly basis provided that:

- (a) the lessee is licensed by the City of Windsor as a taxicab driver;
- (b) all weekly, monthly or yearly leases are filed with and approved by the Licence Commissioner and shall be subject to such terms and conditions the Licence Commissioner may require;
- (c) the amount charged under the lease shall be a fair fee as approved by the Licence Commissioner and no additional charges shall be made against the lessee;
- (d) the lease agreement shall include a statement that the leasing agreement is considered null and void in the event that the lessor or lessee, either by written or verbal agreement, sub-leases the taxicab or taxicab wheelchair accessible vehicle or transfers responsibility for the operation of the taxicab or taxicab wheelchair accessible vehicle to a third party;
- (e) the lease agreement shall contain a clearly-stated right of the lessor and lessee to early termination of the lease;
- (f) where the lessee is a corporation, the lessee shall, at the time at which the lease is filed with the Licence Commissioner in accordance with the provision of this section, file with the Licence Commissioner a form supplied by the Licence Commissioner and a copy of the lessee's articles of incorporation, amendment or amalgamation; and,
- (g) the lease term shall be a minimum of twelve (12) months and a maximum of twenty-four (24) months."

BACKGROUND

- October 15, 2015, transfer application and fee was received on behalf of Mr. Henry Lesperance, being Appendix "A"
- October 19, 2015, transferee application and proof of full-time employment status for Mr. Walid El-Haj was submitted, being Appendices "C" and "D".

SUMMARY

According to Licensing records, Mr. Henry Lesperance has been the plate holder of taxicab plate #173 since 1985 and is therefore compliant with Section 20.1 to Public Vehicle Licensing By-Law 137-2007.

It is being requested that Taxicab Plate #173 be transferred to Mr. Walid El-Haj, who is currently not a licensed plate holder. Further, Licensing records indicate that Mr. El-Haj has been licensed as a taxicab driver since 2011. Although Mr. El-Haj does not hold a current place on the Drivers' List, he has provided proof that he has been employed as a full-time taxicab driver since October 1, 2013, which satisfies the requirements of Section 20.4(a) of Schedule 5.

Administration is prepared to recommend that the transfer be completed pending the following outstanding items:

Mr. Walid El-Haj must provide:

- (a) Verification of an appropriate vehicle to which he will affix taxicab plate #173
- (b) A completed Plate Holder application and pay the associated fee

RECOMMENDATION

To the Windsor Licensing Commission for decision on the following:

- i. **THAT** the transfer of Taxicab Plate #173 from Mr. Henry Lesperance to Mr. Walid El-Haj **BE APPROVED** with the following conditions:
 - Mr. Walid El-Haj be given thirty (30) days from the date of this decision to submit a vehicle for inspection that complies with Schedule 5 to By-law 137-2007.
 - Mr. Walid El-Haj must submit a Plate Holder application and pay the applicable fee.
 - Mr. Walid El-Haj shall not lease the plate for a one year period as stated in Schedule 5, Section 21.3 of Licensing By-law 137-2007.

LICENCE COMMISSIONER’S COMMENTS

This application is a renewal for a Hospitality Food Service licence at 1806 Wyandotte Street West. AMANDA records indicate that the applicant, 1882097 Ontario Ltd. o/a Narenj Restaurant, has been licensed since 2014.

REGULATORY AUTHORITY

Business Licensing By-Law 395-2004

3.8 Licence - application - subject to approval

Every application will be subject to investigations approvals from such municipal or provincial departments or agencies as the Licence Commissioner deems necessary, or as directed by the Windsor Licensing Commission, including but not limited to: Police Services, Windsor/Essex County Health Unit, Fire and Rescue Services Department, Building and Development Department, Environmental Services Department and Licensing and Enforcement Department.

3.25 Licensing powers – Licence Commissioner – issue or renew

- (1) Upon receipt of an application in the prescribed form for a licence or renewal thereof, shall make or cause to be made all investigation required by law and if the investigation disclose any reason to believe that the applicant is not of good character

or that the carrying on of the said trade, calling, business or occupation will be likely to result in a breach of the law or be in any way adverse to the public interest, the Licence Commissioner shall recommend to the Windsor Licensing Commission that it not issue or renew the licence or that it impose conditions on the issuance of a licence, otherwise, the Licence Commissioner shall recommend to the Windsor Licensing Commission that it issue or renew the licence.

3.31 Refusal - suspension - revocation - by Windsor Licensing Commission – hearing

- (1) At the hearing, the Windsor Licensing Commission may suspend, revoke or refuse to issue any licence under this by-law:
- (a) for any reason that would disentitle the holder to a licence if he/she were an applicant;
 - (b) where the holder of the licence or applicant is in breach of a condition of the licence or of this by-law;
 - (c) if there are reasonable grounds to believe that the statements on the licence application are false;
 - (d) if a report is filed subsequent to the date of the issuance of the licence by any department or agency which provided its approval originally to the issuance of the licence which indicates that a licensed premises no longer complies with any of the provisions of this by-law;
 - (e) upon such grounds as are set out in this by-law;
 - (f) if the applicant has outstanding fines or penalties owing to the municipality or has not paid the required licence application fee;
 - (g) if the conduct or character of the applicant or licensee affords reasonable cause to believe that the applicant or licensee will not carry on or engage in the business in accordance with the law or with honesty and integrity;
 - (h) if the geographic location of the business does not meet land use requirements;
 - (i) if, in the case of a corporate applicant or licensee, the conduct of its officers, directors, employees or agents affords reasonable cause to believe that the business will not be engaged in or carried on in accordance with the law or with honesty and integrity; or
 - (j) if issuing a licence is not in the public interest.

BACKGROUND

- May 11, 2015, Mr. Sameh Aghbari made application on behalf of 1882097 Ontario Ltd. o/a Narenj Restaurant for a Hospitality Food Service licence.
- August 25, 2015, Fire Prevention Officer Monique Anger attends the premises at 1806 Wyandotte Street West and enters the following note into the AMANDA system: *Left a business card in the door, business closed for holidays? No date of return on sign.*
- September 1, 2015, Fire Prevention Officer Anger re-attends the premises and enters the following note into the AMANDA system: *Several attempts to contact, business closed for holidays posted on door, no date of return.*
- September 30, 2015, a letter is sent by the Licensing Division to the attention of Mr. Aghbari, advising them of Fire & Rescue Services inability to conduct an inspection at the premises and requesting compliance by October 15, 2015.
- October 20, 2015, Fire Prevention Officer Anger provides an email to the Licensing Division advising that there has been no further progress made.

SUMMARY

Administration recommends to the Windsor Licensing Commission that it refuse to renew a Hospitality Food Service licence to the applicant at 1806 Wyandotte Street West. It is not in the public interest to issue a licence since they have not complied with the requirement to obtain an approval from Fire & Rescue Services. Should the Windsor Licensing Commission decide to refuse to renew the licence, the applicant would be required to re-apply for their licence, pay the applicable fees and submit to an inspection by Fire & Rescue.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the Windsor Licensing Commission **REFUSE TO RENEW** a Hospitality Food Service to 1882097 Ontario Ltd. o/a Narenj Restaurant at 1806 Wyandotte Street West.
