

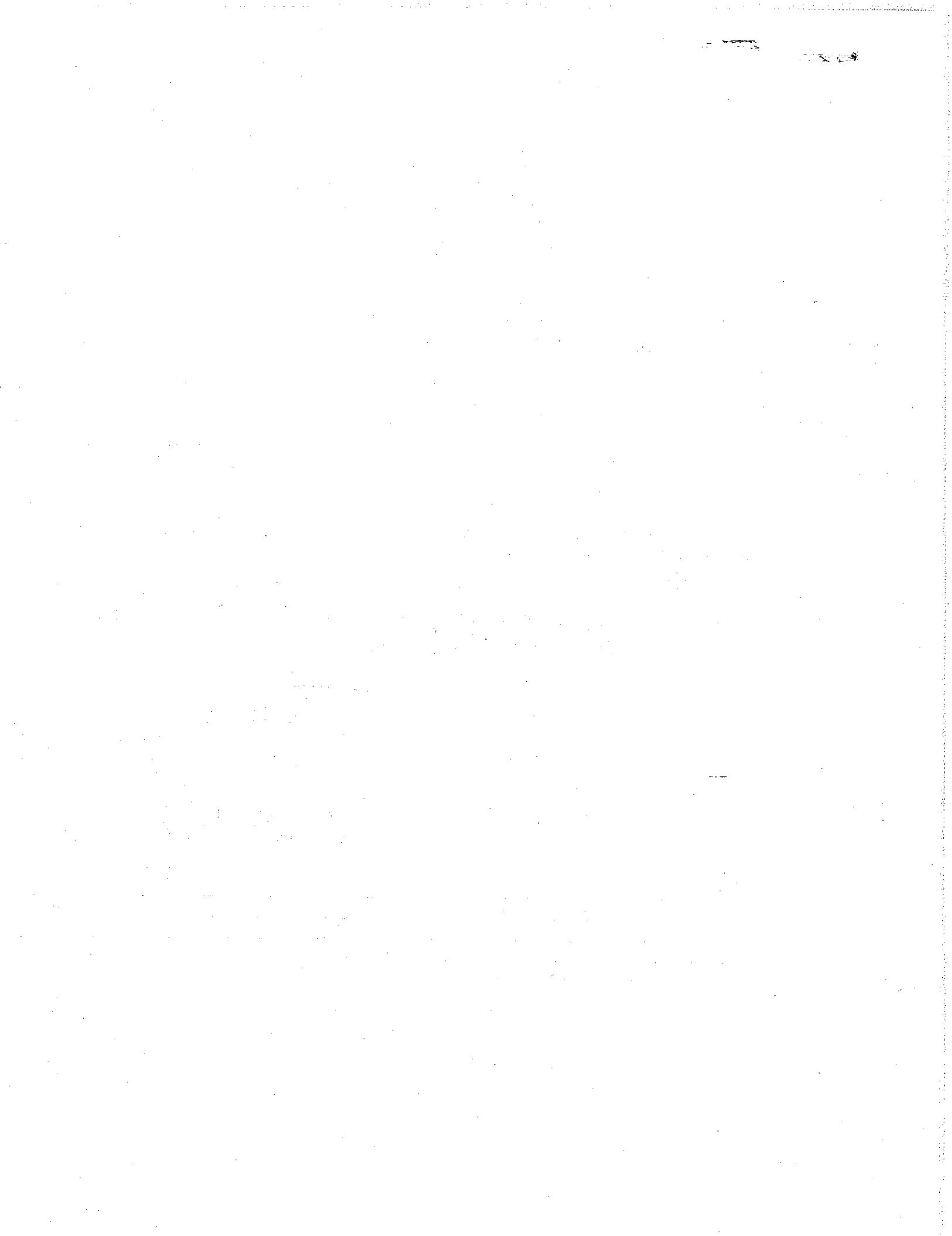

6. **LICENCE TRANSFERS**

(a) **Transfer of Plate #159**

Mr. Kamel Kakish, Transferor and Mr. Mohammad Idrees Aslam, Transferee are present and available to answer questions.

WLC7/14 That the transfer of Taxicab Plate #159 from Mr. Kamel Kakish and Mr. Rajael Kakish to Mr. Mohammad Idrees Aslam **BE APPROVED** with the following conditions:

- Mr. Mohammad Idrees Aslam be given thirty (30) days from the date of this decision to submit a vehicle for inspection that complies with Schedule 5 to By-law 137-2007.
 - Mr. Mohammad Idrees Aslam must submit a Plate Holder application and pay the applicable fee.
 - Mr. Mohammad Idrees Aslam shall not lease the plate for a one year period as stated in Schedule 5, Section 21.3 of Licensing by-law 137-2007.

7. **APPLICATIONS/HEARINGS**

Matthew Stevenson – Guardian of “Wes” – Dangerous Dog

Mr. Matthew Stevenson, guardian of “Wes” is present and available to answer questions. He provides the following comments as it relates to the attack by “Wes” and the subsequent demise of the neighbour’s cat:

- The cat was deaf (owner of the cat provided this information) and was unable to hear the approach of his dog.
- All three of his dogs are friendly.
- “Wes” has a “bad” leg.
- Dogs chase cats and the incident was unfortunate.

In response to a question asked by Councillor Gignac regarding why the dogs were running loose, Mr. Stevenson responds a drywall contractor inadvertently did not latch the gate and the dogs were able to exit the backyard.

Moved by Councillor Sleiman, seconded by Councillor Fathers,
WLC8/14 That DANGEROUS DOG designation **BE PLACED** on the Husky/Akita mix dog known as "Wes" which currently resides with guardian Matthew Stevenson at 2824 Academy Drive, Windsor, Ontario, and further, that the following actions **BE REQUIRED** as a result of this designation:

- To keep such dog, when in or on the property of another person with the person's consent, on a leash and under the control of that person who is sixteen years of age or more.
 - Conspicuously display on his or her property a sign provided by the city warning that there is a dangerous dog on the property.
 - To securely attach a muzzle to such a dog at all times when it is not confined in accordance with section 17(a).
 - To obtain and maintain in force a policy of public liability insurance issued by an insurer licensed by the Province of Ontario providing third party liability coverage in an amount of not less than \$1,000,000. for any damage or injury caused by such potentially dangerous dog and to provide to the Animal Control Officer a Certificate of such policy and each subsequent renewal of it.
 - To insert a microchip implantation in such dog, at the guardian's expense, for the purpose of identifying such dog as a dangerous dog.
 - To restrain the dangerous dog in accordance with any written directives which may be given by an Animal Control Officer.
- Carried.

Councillor Gignac advises she supports the foregoing motion as "Wes" killed the cat, whether the cat was deaf or not.
