**Item 1 Residential Permit Parking Petition for Pitt Street West and Janette Avenue**

**Dan McCullouch, representing the Rosati Group**

Dan McCullouch, representing the Rosati Group appears before the committee to speak in support of administrations recommendation to amend Parking By-Law 9023 to reflect that residential permit parking will be in effect for Pitt Street West from Caron Avenue to Bruce Avenue and Janette Avenue from Pitt Street West to University Avenue West, and concludes by noting that meter parking on the South Side of Pitt Street be included in the Traffic Study that is being conducted for the downtown area.

**Barbara Macedonski, representing City Centre West Neighbourhood Association**

Barbara Macedonski, representing the City Centre West Neighbourhood Association appears before the committee to express concerns with the lack of parking for the residents who live in the area, and concludes by requesting that metered parking be removed and additional residential permit parking be added.

Salient points of discussion regarding the additional permit parking are as follows:

- There is a lack of parking in the area for residents
- Parking is required in order to attract residents to the area
- There is a requirement for more metered parking to allow for the commercial properties in the area
- The Parking By-Law currently allows for 30 minute limited parking and 2 hour parking meters
- Residential Permit Parking will be added to Pitt Street West- North side from Caron Avenue to Bruce Avenue and Janette Avenue – east side from Pitt Street West to University Avenue West
- Two 2 hour meters will be added on Pitt Street West – north Side
- Of the 19 petition area properties 18 or (95%) support the circulated petition
- Notification letters containing instructions will be distributed to the affected property owners if approved.

**THAT** the Parking By-Law 9023 **BE AMENDED** as listed and attached in Appendix “A” of this report to reflect that residential permit parking will be in effect for Pitt Street West from Caron Avenue to Bruce Avenue and Janette Avenue from Pitt Street West to University Avenue West; and further

**THAT** the City Solicitor **PREPARE** the necessary document to amend the Parking By-Law.




