

## **COURT APPROVED NOTICE ABOUT THE WINDSOR “BINGO” LAWSUIT**

**IF YOU ARE A CLASS MEMBER WHO OPTED OUT OF THE WINDSOR “BINGO” CLASS ACTION YOU SHOULD READ THIS NOTICE AS IT CONTAINS IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR RIGHTS**

On January 29, 2016, the Ontario Superior Court of Justice found that the City of Windsor’s and Town of Tecumseh’s multi-media opt-out campaign had the potential to create undue influence on Class Members. A copy of these reasons are enclosed. As a result, the Court ordered that any Class Member who opted out of the Windsor “Bingo” Class Action should have an opportunity to reconsider that decision after the conclusion of the Opt-Out Period. On March 24, 2016, the Ontario Divisional Court upheld this order.

**ANY CLASS MEMBER WHO OPTED OUT NOW HAS THE RIGHT TO RECONSIDER ITS DECISION TO OPT OUT OF THIS CLASS ACTION AND TO REVERSE THAT DECISION ON OR BEFORE OCTOBER 10, 2016.**

If your organization chooses to reconsider and reverse its decision to opt-out, your organization will be a Class Member. Class Members are legally bound by the outcome of the class action. If the class action is successful, only Class Members will have the opportunity to decide whether they want to submit a claim to recover any money from the defendant. Before any Class Member decides whether to make a claim the Court will approve the process by which to make a claim.

Organizations which do not reconsider and remain opted out will not be entitled to directly benefit from any judgment or settlement involving the parties to the Class Action. These organizations have the right to pursue an individual action at their own cost in accordance with the normal rules and laws.

In order to reverse your organization’s decision to opt-out, your organization must fill out the form attached to this notice, or provide the information requested in the form in a signed document.

**ALL RECONSIDERATION FORMS MUST BE RECEIVED BY CLASS COUNSEL BY 11:59P.M. ON MONDAY, OCTOBER 10, 2016**
