PROCLAMATION

"International Day for the Elimination of Violence Against Women"
November 25, 2025

WHEREAS: November is Woman Abuse Prevention Month and November 25th is the International

Day for the Elimination of Violence Against Women; and,

WHEREAS: Violence is the greatest gender inequality rights issue for women, girls, and gender-

diverse individuals. Our community is committed to ending femicide and all forms of

gender-based violence; and,

WHEREAS: Femicide rates are on the rise in Ontario, with over 31 femicides in the province since

November 26, 2024, where 37 different cities and towns in Ontario had a femicide occur

in their community last year; and,

WHEREAS: Indigenous, Black, South Asian, and South East Asian women and girls continue to

experience high rates of violence, including femicide; and,

WHEREAS: Victims on the 2023/24 femicide list range between the ages of 2 months old to 89

years old; and,

WHEREAS: This month, and throughout the 16 Days of Activism Against Gender-Based Violence,

we acknowledge our community's support of the Wrapped in Courage campaign and

commitment to ending gender-based violence; and,

WHEREAS: There is an urgent need for greater investment and action to end gender-based

violence in our community and throughout Ontario by all three levels of government.

THEREFORE: I, Drew Dilkens, Mayor of the City of Windsor, do hereby proclaim

November 25, 2025
