August 31, 2026

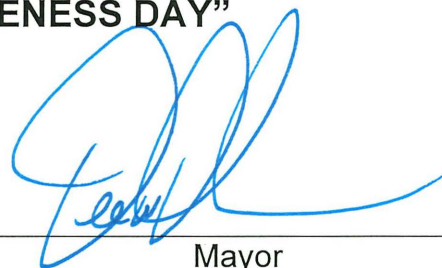
- WHEREAS:** the City of Windsor does affirm and acknowledge the harm and hardship caused by the ongoing toxic drug crisis; and,
