6. Licence Transfers

6(a) Golnar Karimi c/o Estate Trustee of the late Fazlullah Rezagian, Transferor and Rami Khazaley, Transferee appear before the Windsor Licensing Commission regarding the transfer of Taxicab Plate #088.

Craig Robertson provides the following remarks regarding the licence request:

- On August 28, 2024, the Windsor Licensing Commission approved Golnar Karimi, Estate Trustee to hold City of Windsor Taxicab Plate #088 and any associated licenses until September 10, 2025.
- The Commission decided to allow the Estate to hold the plate until they could find an acceptable transferee.
- On August 20, 2025, the Estate Trustee applied for a vehicle transfer through the application process to Mr. Rami Khazaley.

Moved by Sam Sinjari, seconded by Councillor Renaldo Agostino,
That the transfer of Taxicab Plate #088 from The Estate of the late Fazlullah Rezagian to Rami Khazaleh **BE APPROVED** with the following conditions:

- i. Rami Khazaleh given thirty (30) days from the date of the approval to submit a vehicle for inspection that complies with Schedule 5 to By-law 137-2007 as amended, including a valid safety standards certificate.

- ii. Rami Khazaleh given thirty (30) days from the date of the approval to submit a Taxicab Plate Holder application and pay the associated fee.
 - iii. Rami Khazaleh given thirty (30) days from the date of the approval to provide verification that full compensation has been made to Rubina Amjad in consideration of the transfer of Taxicab Plate #88.
 - iv. Rami Khazaleh shall not lease Taxicab plate #88 for a one-year period as stated in Schedule 5, Section 21.3 of Licensing By-Law 137-2007 as amended.

7. Applications/Hearings

(a) Sowmya Shanmuganandam, applicant, appears before the Windsor Licensing Commission regarding a Livery Vehicle, Class D – Van. The application was submitted on August 13, 2025, by the applicant on behalf of 17221346 Canada Inc. The By-law does cap the number of Class – D Livery vehicles to 30 (currently there is 1 licence). The applicant has not purchased a vehicle as of yet but is proposing a 2024 Chrysler Grand Caravan SXT which would be within the age limit requirement under the By-law being under 10 years of age.

- Sowmya Shanmuganandam be given sixty (60) days from the date of this decision to submit a Business Name Registration and a certificate of insurance that is satisfactory to Section 9.1 of Schedule 3 to By-law 137-2007 as amended,
- Purchase the 2024 Chrysler Grand Caravan SXT, or a similar vehicle.
- Submit vehicle ownership and current Safety Standards Certificate,
- The vehicle must submit to and pass an inspection by the By-law Enforcement Unit.

Licence Commissioner's Comments:

The attached authorization letter and applications were received by the Licensing Division on December 12, 2025, from Mohammad Waddah Rashash on behalf of Kedir Shamy, Plate Holder of Taxicab Plate #055, and from Abdullah Saleem for the prospective transfer of Taxicab Plate #055.

Regulatory Authority:

Schedule 4, Part VII, Section 20.1 through 20.4 of Licensing By-law No, 137-2007 as amended states:

"20.1 Except as approved by the Licensing Commission, a taxicab plate holder may not transfer a taxicab plate and associated taxicab plate holder licence for a period of at least five (5) years from the date of issue of the licence.

20.2 No taxicab plate holder licence shall be transferred without the approval of the Licensing Commission.

20.3 No taxicab plate holder licence shall be transferred until the person to whom the transfer is to be made has first received approval from the Licence Commissioner as a licensee.

20.4 Subject to the restrictions herein, taxicab plates numbered 001 to 224 are transferable, provided that:

- (a) the transferee satisfies the eligibility criteria for inclusion on the Drivers' List;
- (b) the transferee signs a form of statutory declaration prescribed by the Licence Commissioner;
- (c) the transferor has completed a written application for the transfer in the prescribed form;
- (d) the transferee satisfies the requirements of a taxicab plate holder under this By-law, including submitting for inspection the taxicab to which the plate will be affixed;
- (e) the transferee pays all fees required under this By-law;

and the transferee will receive a taxicab plate holder licence at the time of transfer of the taxicab plate."

Item No. 6(a)

Further, Section 21.3 states:

“A taxicab or taxicab wheelchair accessible vehicle plate holder who has held a licence for a minimum of one (1) year may lease the taxicab or taxicab wheelchair accessible vehicle licence on a daily, weekly, monthly or yearly basis provided that:

- (a) the lessee is licensed by the City of Windsor as a taxicab driver;
- (b) all weekly, monthly or yearly leases are filed with and approved by the Licence Commissioner and shall be subject to such terms and conditions the Licence Commissioner may require;
- (c) the amount charged under the lease shall be a fair fee as approved by the Licence Commissioner and no additional charges shall be made against the lessee;
- (d) the lease agreement shall include a statement that the leasing agreement is considered null and void in the event that the lessor or lessee, either by written or verbal agreement, sub-leases the taxicab or taxicab wheelchair accessible vehicle or transfers responsibility for the operation of the taxicab or taxicab wheelchair accessible vehicle to a third party;
- (e) the lease agreement shall contain a clearly-stated right of the lessor and lessee to early termination of the lease;
- (f) where the lessee is a corporation, the lessee shall, at the time at which the lease is filed with the Licence Commissioner in accordance with the provision of this section, file with the Licence Commissioner a form supplied by the Licence Commissioner and a copy of the lessee's articles of incorporation, amendment or amalgamation; and,
- (g) the lease term shall be a minimum of twelve (12) months and a maximum of twenty-four (24) months.”

Background:

The following is the chronology of events as it relates to the licence transfer request:

- December 12, 2025, authorization letter was submitted by Mohammad Waddah Rashash on behalf of Kedir Shamy, being Appendix “A”
- December 12, 2025, transfer application and fee for taxicab plate #055 was submitted by Mohammad Waddah Rashash on behalf of Kedir Shamy, being Appendix “B”
- December 12, 2025, transferee application and proof of full-time status as a taxicab driver for Abdullah Saleem was submitted, being Appendices “C” and “D”.

Summary:

According to the City's licensing database, Kedri Shamy has been the plate holder of taxicab plate #055 annually since 2018. Section 20.1 of Schedule 4 to Public Vehicle

Item No. 6(a)

Licensing By-Law No. 137-2007 as amended states that a plate may not be transferred for a period of at least five (5) years from the date of issue of the licence unless otherwise approved by the Windsor Licensing Commission. Therefore, the transfer would be in compliance with the by-law.

It is being requested that Taxicab Plate #055 be transferred to Abdullah Saleem, who is currently not a licensed plate holder. Although Abdullah Saleem does not hold a current place on the Drivers' List, he has provided proof that he has been employed as a full-time taxicab driver since June 2016, which also satisfies the requirements of the City's Public Vehicle Licensing By-law.

The transferee has proposed that upon licence approval, that taxicab plate #055 will be affixed to a 2017, Toyota Rav 4. The vehicle in question meets the age requirements under the by-law, however, the vehicle will be subject to inspection and approval from the By-law Enforcement Division.

Administration is prepared to recommend that the transfer of taxicab plate #055 be approved, based on the circumstances noted that the transferee meets all requirements as indicated under Schedule 4 to Public Vehicle Licensing By-law No. 137-2007 as amended. In addition, Abdullah Saleem, the prospective transferee must provide the Licensing Division with the following:

- (a) Verification of an appropriate vehicle to which he will affix taxicab plate #055, including a valid safety standards certificate;
- (b) Submit said vehicle for inspection and approval from the By-law Enforcement Division as applicable;
- (c) A completed Taxicab Plate Holder application and pay the associated fee;
- (d) Verification that full compensation has been made to Kedri Shamy in consideration of the transfer of taxicab plate #055.

Recommendation:

To the Windsor Licensing Commission for decision on the following:

THAT the transfer of Taxicab Plate #055 from Kedri Shamy to Abdullah Saleem **BE APPROVED** with the following conditions:

- i. Abdullah Saleem be given thirty (30) days from the date of the approval to submit a vehicle for inspection that complies with Schedule 4 to Public Vehicle Licensing By-law No. 137-2007 as amended, including a valid safety standards certificate.
- ii. Abdullah Saleem be given thirty (30) days from the date of the approval to submit a Taxicab Plate Holder application and pay the associated fee.
- iii. Abdullah Saleem be given thirty (30) days from the date of the approval to provide verification that full compensation has been made to Kedri Shamy in consideration of the transfer of Taxicab plate #055.
- iv. Abdullah Saleem shall not lease Taxicab plate #055 for a one-year period as stated in Schedule 4, Section 21.3 of Public Vehicle Licensing By-law No. 137-2007 as amended.

- v. Abdullah Saleem shall not transfer plate #055 for a period of at least five (5) years from the date of issue of the licence unless otherwise approved by the Windsor Licensing Commission, as stated in Schedule 4, Section 20.1 of Public Vehicle Licensing By-law No. 137-2007 as amended.





20.2 No taxicab plate holder licence shall be transferred without the approval of the Licensing Commission.

20.3 No taxicab plate holder licence shall be transferred until the person to whom the transfer is to be made has first received approval from the Licence Commissioner as a licensee.

20.4 Subject to the restrictions herein, taxicab plates numbered 001 to 224 are transferable, provided that:

- (a) the transferee satisfies the eligibility criteria for inclusion on the Drivers' List;
- (b) the transferee signs a form of statutory declaration prescribed by the Licence Commissioner;
- (c) the transferor has completed a written application for the transfer in the prescribed form;
- (d) the transferee satisfies the requirements of a taxicab plate holder under this By-law, including submitting for inspection the taxicab to which the plate will be affixed;
- (e) the transferee pays all fees required under this By-law;

and the transferee will receive a taxicab plate holder licence at the time of transfer of the taxicab plate.”

Further, Section 21.3 states:

“A taxicab or taxicab wheelchair accessible vehicle plate holder who has held a licence for a minimum of one (1) year may lease the taxicab or taxicab wheelchair accessible vehicle licence on a daily, weekly, monthly or yearly basis provided that:

- (a) the lessee is licensed by the City of Windsor as a taxicab driver;

- (d) the lease agreement shall include a statement that the leasing agreement is considered null and void in the event that the lessor or lessee, either by written or verbal agreement, sub-leases the taxicab or taxicab wheelchair accessible vehicle or transfers responsibility for the operation of the taxicab or taxicab wheelchair accessible vehicle to a third party;
- (e) the lease agreement shall contain a clearly-stated right of the lessor and lessee to early termination of the lease;
- (f) where the lessee is a corporation, the lessee shall, at the time at which the lease is filed with the Licence Commissioner in accordance with the provision of this section, file with the Licence Commissioner a form supplied by the Licence Commissioner and a copy of the lessee's articles of incorporation, amendment or amalgamation; and,
- (g) the lease term shall be a minimum of twelve (12) months and a maximum of twenty-four (24) months."

Background:

The following is the chronology of events as it relates to the licence transfer request:

- December 16, 2025, transfer application and fee for taxicab plate #219 was submitted by Nasr Mohamed Al-Shaibie, being Appendix "A"
- December 16, 2025, transferee application and proof of full-time status as a taxicab driver for Nasr Amed Abulelah Manea Abuhamra was submitted, being Appendices "B" and "C".

Summary:

According to the City's licensing database, Nasr Mohamed Al-Shaibie has been the plate holder of taxicab plate #219 annually since 2023. Section 20.1 of Schedule 4 to Public Vehicle Licensing By-Law No. 137-2007 as amended states that a plate may not be transferred for a period of at least five (5) years from the date of issue of the licence unless otherwise approved by the Windsor Licensing Commission. Therefore, the transfer would be in compliance with the by-law.



(b) The applicant shall file with the Licence Commissioner evidence of ownership of such livery vehicle and proof that the livery vehicle to be licensed under this By-law has a valid vehicle permit issued under the Highway Traffic Act and is either registered in the name of the applicant or leased to the applicant;

(e) the applicant shall file with the Licence Commissioner a safety standards certificate issued within 30 days of the date of the applicant's application;"

9.1 Every applicant for a livery vehicle plate holder licence shall file with the Licence Commissioner either a copy of the insurance policy or a certificate of insurance in respect of the livery vehicle which insurance shall meet the following requirements:

- (a) issuance by an insurer duly authorized to issue insurance within the Province of Ontario;
- (b) for each livery vehicle, liability coverage is in the amount of not less than THREE MILLION DOLLARS (\$3,000,000.00) for personal injury or property damage arising out of any one accident or occurrence;
- (c) it shall not be cancelled by the insurer until after fifteen (15) days written notice of such cancellation is given to the Licence Commissioner; and,
- (d) the owner of the livery vehicle shall be named as the insured and all insured livery vehicles shall be listed and described.

10.9 No Class 'D' livery vehicle shall be more than ten (10) model years in age.




