



Mayoral Direction MD 13-2025

To Direct staff to undertake research and provide advice to the head of council and city council on policies and programs of the City

WHEREAS pursuant to Part V1.1 (Special Powers and Duties of Head of Council) of the *Municipal Act, 2001, Sections 284.3 and 284.4* (Direction to Employees) the Mayor may direct staff to:

- a) undertake research and provide advice to the head of council and city council on policies and programs of the Municipality or of the head of Council as they relate to the powers and duties under this Part; and
- b) carry out duties related to the exercise of the power or performance of the duty, including implementing any decisions made by the head of council under this Part;

and

WHEREAS City Council approved the stormwater financing plan with the understanding that residential homeowner billings were expected to decrease on an annual basis for combined wastewater/stormwater charges, and since the implementation some residents have indicated an increase to their recent bills;

I, Drew Dilkens, Mayor of the City of Windsor direct as follows:

That Administration be directed to report back to City Council regarding the storm water financing program with the following information:

- 1) A detailed analysis of the impact on pre-existing residential ENWIN customers as a result of the separation of the wastewater and stormwater billings. If the analysis demonstrates an outcome that is materially different than what had been reported publicly that Administration provide City Council with all reasonable

options for consideration to affect the expected decrease.

- 2) An analysis which includes the number of homeowners currently on septic systems for which no wastewater charge was previously charged and the total monthly stormwater revenue now being collected from these homeowners.
