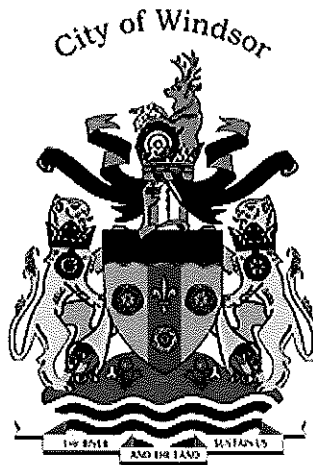




The Corporation of the City of Windsor

Mayoral Decision MD 23-2025

To Direct staff to undertake research and provide advice to the head of Council and City Council on policies and programs of the City

WHEREAS pursuant to Part VI.1 (Special Powers and Duties of The Head of Council) of the *Municipal Act, 2001: Sections 234.3 (Direction to Employees)*, the Mayor may direct municipal employees to:

- a) Undertake research and provide advice to the head of Council and City Council on policies and programs of the City or of the head of Council as they relate to the powers and duties under this Part ; and
- b) Carry out duties related to the exercise of the power or performance of the duty, including implementing any decisions made by the head of Council under this Part; and,

WHEREAS pursuant to *Subsection 284.16 (1) of the Municipal Act, 2001*, and *section 7 of O. Regulation 530/22*, the Mayor shall, on or before February 1 of each year, prepare a proposed budget to Council for its consideration;

THEREFORE, I, Drew Dilkens, Mayor of the City of Windsor direct as follows:

THAT City Administration prepare a proposed 2026 budget that achieves a 0% tax levy while maintaining funding for the City's Asset Management Plan, and continues to invest in infrastructure, growth, and development through the 10-year capital plan to include the largest local road rehabilitation and repair program in the City's history.
