



The Corporation of the City of Windsor

Mayoral Decision 26-2025

WHEREAS pursuant to Part V1.1 (Special Powers and Duties of Head of Council) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, Sections 284.3 (Direction to Employees) the Mayor may direct municipal employees to:

- a. Undertake research and provide advice to the head of council and city council on policies and programs of the City or of the head of Council as they relate to the powers and duties under this Part; and
- b. Carry out duties related to the exercise of the power or performance of the duty, including implementing any decisions made by the head of council under this Part; and,

WHEREAS pursuant to subsection 284.16 (1) of the *Municipal Act, 2001* and section 7 of 0. Regulation 530/22, the Mayor shall, on or before February 1 of each year, prepare a proposed budget to Council for its consideration;


THEREFORE I, Drew Dilkens, Mayor of the City of Windsor decides and direct as follows:

Pursuant to subsection 284.16(1) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, I hereby table the 2026 Budget for the Corporation of the City of Windsor ("2026 Recommended Budget"); and further,

That the Clerk be directed to provide copies of the 2026 Recommended Budget (inclusive of both the Operating and 10-Year Capital Budget documents) to each member of Council;

That the Clerk be directed to make the 2026 Recommended Budget publicly available and considered tabled on the City of Windsor's website no later than Monday, December 29, 2025;

That the Clerk be directed to schedule a meeting of Council for Monday, January 12, 2026 to allow for budget delegations; Monday, January 26, 2026 for budget deliberations and to schedule any additional meeting dates as requested by Council following the release of the 2026 Recommended Budget for Council to consider all budget documents and allow for any amendments to be considered within the required 30-day timeframe (or shorter period as amended by Council resolution).
