SPECIES SPOTLIGHT:

Yellow Trout Lily

The spotted leaves of this early spring wildflower look a bit like a trout, which is how it got its name. It pops up and blooms quickly to soak up the sunshine before the trees unfurl their leaves. Even when you can't see them, trout lilies can hide underground and live for many years!

LOOK FOR:

Eastern garter snakes, large white trilliums, wood thrushes, western chorus frogs, Jack-in-the-pulpit
