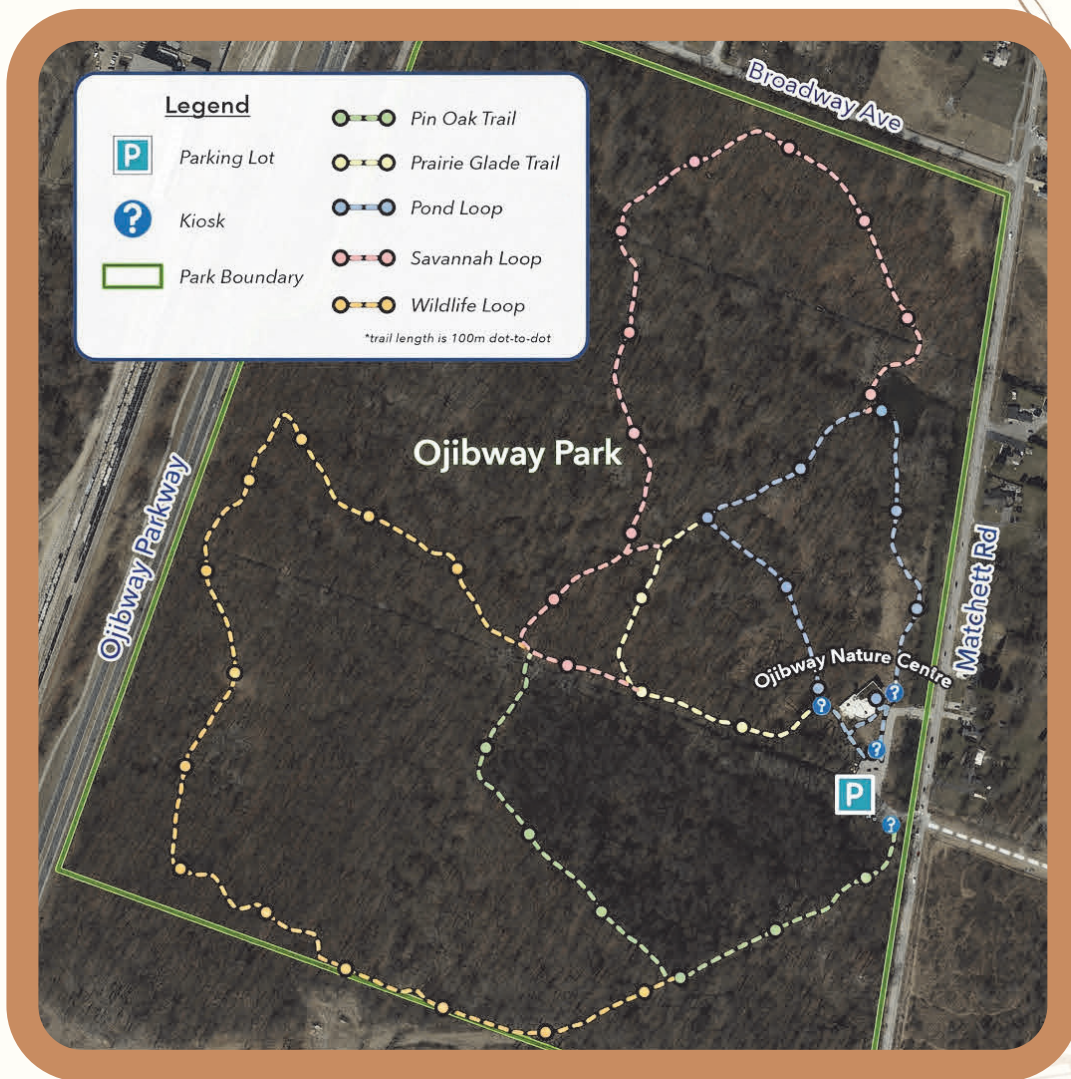


Ojibway Park

SPECIES SPOTLIGHT:

Tufted Titmouse

Listen for this small gray songbird with a pointy crest calling *peter-peter-peter* from the trees.

These curious and social birds are often found foraging alongside chickadees and nuthatches, and are known for stealthily collecting tufts of animal (and human!) hair to line their nests.

LOOK FOR:

White-tailed deer, chipmunks, snapping turtles, mayapple, black-capped chickadees
