SPECIES SPOTLIGHT:

Dense Blazing Star

Once common across Ontario's tallgrass communities, this beacon for butterflies lights up the prairie with its tall purple flower spikes each summer.

Unlike most flowers, it blooms from the top down, offering a steady nectar supply that keeps insect pollinators coming back for more during the height of the season.

LOOK FOR:

Duskywing butterflies, sassafras trees, eastern bluebirds, northern leopard frogs
