SPECIES SPOTLIGHT:

Green Frog

Despite its name, this amphibian isn't always bright green; it often takes on shades of olive or bronze, helping it blend seamlessly into the marshy edges of wetlands.

Common yet charismatic, the green frog plays an important role in the prairie's wetland chorus. Listen closely and you might catch its throaty call, often compared to the loose, twangy pluck of a banjo string.

LOOK FOR:

Tall coreopsis, yellow star grass, woodland sunflower, green herons, wood ducks
