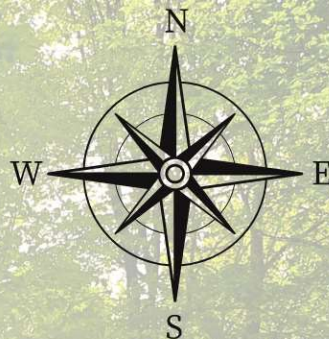




# EXPLORE PECHE ISLAND

- ALL PASSENGERS MUST SIGN A WAIVER AND SHOW PHOTO ID.
- MINORS UNDER 18 MUST BE WITH AN ADULT.
