Commemorative Tree Program

The City of Windsor's Commemorative Tree Program, now running for over 30 years remains to be an integral part of the City's tree planting program. Over the years, this program has seen more than 600 trees be planted throughout the City. These trees offer many environmental benefits to our community such as an increase in shade, cleaner air and water, while providing habitat to our local wild life.

This program allows for the purchase of a tree and an optional personalized bronze plaque to be planted in memory of a loved one such as a family member or a friend or to commemorate any special event in your family or circle of friends.



The gift of a tree is a lasting tribute to not only your family and friends but also to the community by enhancing the natural environment.

After choosing a park, please fill out the order form and send it by mail or in person to the Parks main office. The City requires that you pay in full for the tree and plaque (optional) at the time of ordering.

Most of the City's parks are eligible for this tree planting program and many of our past donors choose a park that has special meaning to the family. Our Forestry staff will meet with you on site to select the ideal planting spot in your park of choice and will help you choose a suitable tree fit for the site and pleasing to the eye.

Please note that plaques cannot be purchased for installation on existing mature park trees.



Commemorative Tree Cost

A bronze plaque (8"x6") set in a cement block (14"x17"x5") placed at the base of the tree, is an additional \$1,030.



Terms

Trees are planted each spring and fall and we take orders all year round. Tree species are subject to change in any given year. The trees are watered for the first two growing seasons and fresh mulch is applied on a bi-yearly basis or as needed during the first 5 years of its life.

Should the tree die and or the plaque be vandalized or stolen, the City will replace the tree and or the plaque once in the first 5 years. Following the fifth year, all replacements costs will be the responsibility of the donor. The placement of memorial wreaths, flowers or ornaments on or in the tree is not permitted and these items will be removed and discarded without notice.
