HYDRO PROJECTS: CABANA CORRIDOR IMPROVEMENTS - PHASE 4 - CABANA RD W FROM CURRY AVE TO HURON CHURCH RD – HYDRO POLES RELOCATION

Starting May, 2022 ENWIN Utilities Ltd. is planning to renew its electrical distribution facilities (poles, cables and transformers) in your area. The reconstruction is required to accommodate a City road widening project and so that overloaded and deteriorated plant can be replaced and upgraded. The net result will be a distribution system which will provide more reliable electricity through a variety of environmental and loading conditions.

Over the next few weeks red wooden stakes will be installed to indicate approximate locations of new pole lines.

ENWIN will do everything possible to minimize the impact to our customers during this scheduled upgrade. Some customers may experience brief power interruptions and ENWIN will make all reasonable efforts to notify affected customers in advance. ENWIN may also need to trim or remove trees in order to complete work, install new plant and maintain minimum required clearances. Customers may also notice the temporary storage of construction materials within the public right of way. Minor traffic disruptions may also occur from time to time. We ask that drivers and pedestrians exercise caution when nearing the work site.

Affected lawn areas will be restored with topsoil and sod. The Contractor will be required to water and maintain the lawn for 30 days after it is placed. Once the 30 day period expires, lawn maintenance, including watering, weeding and mowing is the sole responsibility of the homeowner. Driveways and sidewalks will be restored to City of Windsor specifications. ENWIN will take photos before, during and after construction to ensure proper restoration.

The work of replacing poles and associated equipment will be performed by our contractor Black and McDonald and is expected to begin on May 23, 2022, and end on December 20, 2022, weather and circumstances permitting. Regular work hours will be from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. with the possibility of extending daylight working hours in order to complete the work in a timely manner.

Your patience and co-operation is appreciated during the construction period.
