**Downtown Windsor Utilities and Streetscape Improvements Phase 6** 

**Ouellette Avenue – from Wyandotte Street to Elliott Street** 

The City of Windsor is proceeding with Phase 6 of the Downtown Windsor Utility and Streetscape Improvements on Ouellette Avenue from Wyandotte Street to Elliott Street as shown on the attached map. **Dillon Consulting Ltd.** has been retained as the City's Consultant for design and project administration of this project.

The construction contract for this project has been awarded to **J & J Lepera Infrastructures Inc.** with Mr. Joe Lepera as Project Manager (telephone 519-972-1700). Dillon Consulting Ltd. will administer this project including on-site inspections on behalf of the City of Windsor. # **Project Description**

The reconstruction will take place from building face to building face and will include surface, water and drainage improvements. Key features of this project include: a revised cross section to facilitate two lanes of traffic with on-street parking, new street and pedestrian lighting, introduction of a "flex zone" to allow for patios and public events, new paving materials, plantings and many other streetscape amenities.

#### **Construction Schedule and Staging**

The construction will commence the week of August 28, 2017, subject to weather conditions. Traffic detour signage will be installed in advance of construction. It is anticipated that construction will be complete by the fall of 2018.

In order to minimize impact on local traffic and businesses, construction will be staged to minimize the inconvenience. The tentative staging of the construction is summarized below:

Fall 2017 Reconstruction of the Wyandotte Street and Ouellette Avenue intersection and

installation of watermain and services on Ouellette from Wyandotte Street to

Elliott Street.

Spring/Summer Road construction and streetscaping improvements on Ouellette from

2018 Wyandotte Street to Elliott Street.

# Pre-construction Survey

Prior to construction commencing, the Contractor or its designated agent will conduct a preconstruction survey of the adjacent properties and buildings, which will include photographs and videotaping.



# **Watermain Construction**

As part of an ongoing infrastructure renewal program, the Windsor Utilities Commission (WUC) will be installing new watermains on Ouellette Avenue from Wyandotte Street to Elliott Street.

# Will my water supply be interrupted?

Answer: Yes, there will be a <u>short</u>, <u>planned</u> interruption of less than **4** hours when your water service is connected to the new watermain. The onsite ENWIN watermain inspector will attempt to notify you in person prior to this shutdown. Unplanned interruptions may occur if the old watermain breaks during construction.

Construction started several days ago and my water was brown this morning, why did this happen and what should I do?

Answer: Periodically, the watermain work causes disturbances in the old watermain. Run a cold water tap closest to your water meter until the water runs clear.

#### **Municipal Waste Collection**

Garbage / recycling / yard waste will continue to be collected on the scheduled days. Pickup will continue as normal for alleys during construction.

#### <u>Businesses</u>

During construction, signs and detours will be posted indicating that the roads are closed, but local traffic will be accommodated as much as possible. All businesses will remain open during construction.

# **Encroachments**

Any objects currently in the right-of-way, which have been, or have not been legalized through an encroachment or outdoor patio agreement (fencing, patios, bushes, or other landscaping, etc.), will be removed during construction, and disposed of. Alternatively, you may wish to remove them yourself, prior to our contractor doing so.
