Belle Isle View Boulevard – Sewer, Watermain, Pavement, and Streetlighting
Rehabilitation**

Due to approaching cold weather, the Belle Isle View Boulevard rehabilitation project will not be fully completed this year. The sewers, watermain, road pavement, and curb and gutter on Belle Isle View Boulevard from Wyandotte Street East to St. Rose Avenue are completed.

All remaining work will be completed in the spring of 2020, including grading of top soil and sod installation to damaged areas, and installation of driveway approaches.


The surface asphalt layer will be installed in fall of 2020.

It is inevitable that the above-mentioned construction will cause some inconvenience in the area; however, every effort will be made to minimize these inconveniences.
