How to Book

- tours depart Lakeview Park Marina every Wednesday, Thursday & Saturday June-October (weather permitting)
- to pre-register contact Centralized Registration & Booking Centre 519-255-1161 or by email at CRBC@citywindsor.ca
- arrive at Lakeview Park Marina 15 minutes prior to your departure
- all visitors must sign a waiver and provide photo ID prior to departure
- anyone under 18 years of age must be accompanied by an adult
- parking will be available near the marina at the corner of Riverside Drive and Riverdale
- in the event of inclement weather and cancellation you will be notified in a timely manner

RESTRICTIONS

- NO swimming & NO access to beach due to strong currents and deep water
- NO bikes or pets
- NO alcohol, fishing or fires
- DO NOT feed the animals
- DO NOT wander off the trails (poison ivy)
