

Grasscycling is the simple, but effective, it's the act of leaving your grass clippings on the lawn instead of bagging them.

Grass clippings are a great natural fertilizer. Due to the high moisture content in grass clippings (they are 85-90% water), clippings will quickly decay, returning valuable nutrients back into the soil. This naturally fertilizes and strengthens your lawn making the turf more resistant to disease, resulting in a healthier lawn. One bag of clippings equals 100 grams of fertilizer rich in phosphorus, nitrogen and potassium. Leaving your clippings on your lawn allows all those nutrients to return back to the turf where they will do the most good.

Grasscycling is simple, after all what could be easier than just leaving the clippings on the lawn. It's cheaper, you save on fertilizer costs, and you don't have to pay to dispose of clippings.

Grasscycling promotes a thick, weed-free lawn - with no need for chemical pesticides - healthier for you, your kids and your pets!
