For subsequent benefit periods, they expect to have no employment or self-employment income.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Additionally, part-time workers performing essential services earning less than \$2,500 per month, other part-time workers earning less than \$1,000 per month, seasonal workers, and those who have recently run out of Employment Insurance may qualify
