Description:	To support regular transit users, Windsor City Council has approved a one-time payment for individuals who purchased a pass between February 19, 2020 and March 19, 2020 or held a monthly pass valid for the period between February 19, 2020 and March 19, 2020.	
Special Conditions:	Subject to verification, one-time payment includes: 1) Student Union at University will receive a payment equivalent to about \$25 per student, 2) Regular pass holders (Adult, Student, Senior) need to apply for payment on-line to be eligible for a \$50 amount. The City provides over 2,500 passes to low-income and vulnerable individuals who receive a bus pass as part of their social assistance program.	

	These individuals will not need to apply and will receive a \$75 payment.
