What to Know *before* You Go!

HOW TO BOOK

- tours depart Lakeview Park Marina every wednesday, saturday & sunday June-October (weather permitting)
- to pre-register contact 519-253-2300
- arrive 30 minutes prior to your departure
- all visitors must sign a waiver and provide photo ID prior to departure
- anyone under 18 years of age must be accompanied by an adult
- parking will be available near Lakeview Park Marina at the corner of riverside dr. and riverdale
- in the event of inclement weather and cancellation you will be notified in a timely manner



WHAT TO PACK

- personal photo identification
- bug and sun protection
- reusable waterbottles are encouraged
- one small personal pack* (i.e. purse, backpack)
- binoculars

LEAVE NO TRACE

please pack out what you have packed in

WHAT TO DO

- **EXPLORE** 86 acres of island
- **DISCOVER** the island's history
- **EXPERIENCE** the rustic trails, canals and ruins
- **ENJOY** the picturesque skyline view of windsor and detroit



RESTRICTED ACTIVITIES INCLUDE

- NO swimming & NO access to beach due to strong currents and deep water
- NO bikes or pets
- NO alcohol, fishing or fires
- DO NOT feed the animals
- DO NOT wander off the trails (poison ivy)



WHAT TO WEAR

- dress for the weather
- walking shoes - lots of trails to discover
- a hat
