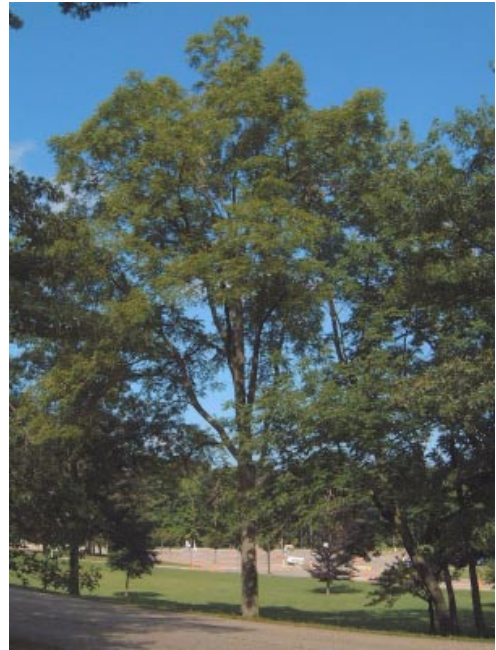


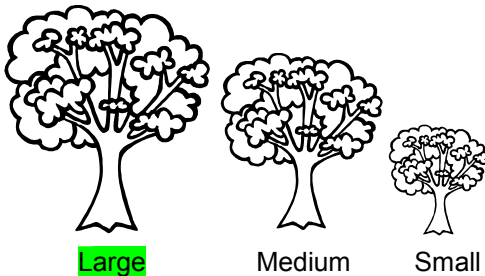
# Black Walnut

*Juglans nigra*

Hardiness Zone	5
Mature Height	50 - 90 feet
Mature Form	Oval to rounded with an open crown
Features	Coarse compound leaves in summer; edible nuts in round husks in early autumn
Insect or Diseases	No common problems
Culture	Full sun; moist, well drained soil; tolerates drought, alkaline pH
Notes	Difficult to transplant due to deep taproot; the roots of black walnut produce a chemical, juglone, that can be toxic to certain plants
