

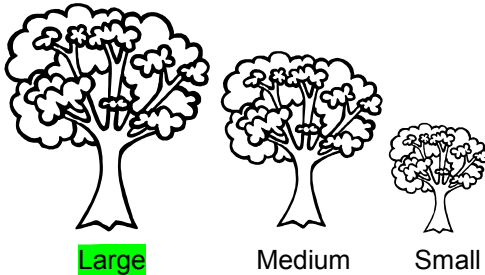
Common Hackberry

Celtis occidentalis

Hardiness Zone	4
Mature Height	50-90 feet
Mature Form	Rounded to somewhat vase-shaped
Features	Mild yellow fall color, trunk covered with warty projections that are interesting in winter
Insect or Diseases	No common problems except nipple gall which is a cosmetic problem that does no real damage
Culture	Full sun; best in moist, well-drained soils, but tolerates moderately wet, dry and alkaline sites
Notes	This relative of elms is not affected by Dutch Elm Disease
