

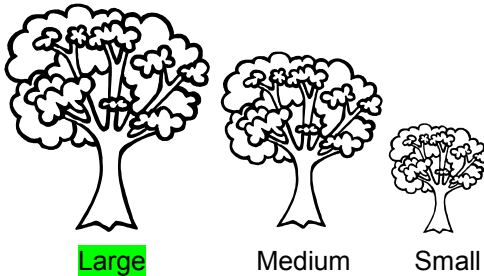
Red Oak

Quercus rubra

Hardiness Zone 4
 Mature Height 60-75 feet
 Mature Form Rounded
 Features Fall color varies from red to russet to yellow brown; form
 Insect or Diseases Oak wilt is a potential problem, gypsy moth (other problems are possible, but usually not serious)
 Culture Full sun; moist, well-drained soil; prefers acid soil
 Notes Iron chlorosis (yellowing of the leaves) can occur on this species when planted in alkaline soils; easy to transplant due to a fibrous root system
