

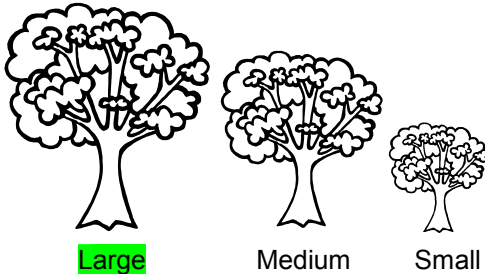
Swamp White Oak

Quercus bicolor

Hardiness Zone 4
 Mature Height 50-60 feet
 Mature Form Rounded to broad rounded
 Features Yellow to yellow brown fall color; form
 Insect or Diseases Anthracnose (other problems are possible, but usually not serious)
 Culture Full sun; tolerant of both wet and dry sites; needs acid soil pH
 Notes Iron chlorosis (yellowing of leaves) may occur if soil pH is too high; compared to other oaks fairly easy to transplant due to lack of a taproot
