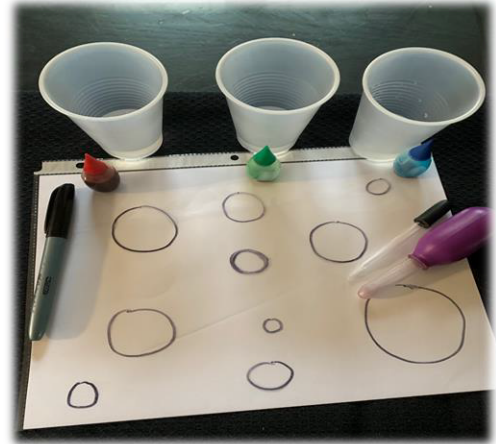


How Many Drops to Fill the Circles?

WHAT YOU WILL NEED:

- Paper or cardstock
- Sheet protector or Ziploc bag
- A few cups
- Food colouring
- Pipette
- Permanent marker



WHAT TO DO NEXT:

1. Draw several different size circles on your paper. Place your paper in a sheet protector or Ziploc bag.
2. Pour some water into each cup and add a few drops of food colouring.
3. Estimate how many drops of water it will take to fill each circle.
4. Use the pipette to squeeze drops of water onto each circle and count the drops as you go.
5. Compare how many drops of water it took to fill a large circle and a small circle.
6. Have fun counting, comparing, estimating, and looking at the colours!
7. Keep some paper towels on hand to dry the sheet and repeat the activity.
